

Bark Catherine went out Cape Verde
Saturday Sep^r 23rd 1848

160

Commenced with fine breeze from S.E.
Sailed down the side of Gal
saw the Ship going Laying at anchor
At 2 P.M. saw the Island of
Bonavita bearing S.E. by E. per compass.
Midle part steering S.W. under short sail
Later part at 10 A.M. made the Island of
S. S. Sago. Later part running down the side

Sunday 24th Where 24 hours commenced
with fine weather and smart breeze from
S.E. steering for the Harbour of
Port Praya. At 4 P.M. came to anchor
with the Redoubt Rich of Boston & the
Bark Iris of New London.
got 150 Bbls of Water, fruit, Hogs & Cows
Had one days Liberty each Watch.

Wednesday 27th At daylight got under
way with a fine breeze from S.E.
Steering S.W. Left the Boston Bark
and the Ship Mercury West of New Bedford
at anchor.

Where 24 hours commenced with smart
breeze from S.W. bore S.W. at midle
part light air from the Westward
Later part the same. saw 6 or 7 sail
of vessels steering to Southward & Eastward
Lat 12.12.35 Long

Friday 29th Where 24 hours commenced with
fine weather and light air. Midle & Later part
the same Ship heading to South.
saw 4 or 6 sail. Lat 11.35 Long

Saturday 30th Where 24 hours commenced
with light air from Eastward & Westward
Midle & Later part being equally weather
four or five sail in sight.
Lat Long

Sunday October 1st 1848
Where 24 hours commenced
with being equally weather. At first
part 2 P.M. Spotted the Ship
Mercurien Bicorn of New London
3 months out bound bound to
Soolation. Three other sail in sight
one Whaling Brig Ship heading to
S.E. at midle part heading to
S.W. Later part heading to South
fine weather. Lat Long
