lowering. the whale took the line the
starboard Boat bent on. the whale run
until about 5 P.M. then the line parted
and the whale went to the windward
middle part squally latter part the same
the whale would have made 30 bbls of oil
if we could have got him but the ice was in
the way

Wednesday 30th At first part
commenced with smart breeze from
South & West Course E by S. So much
there 24 of them.

Thursday 31st At first part smart
breeze from the Westward steering E by S & S.
Middle & latter parts light airs from
the Northward. steering E by S & S.
Latt Long
