107 The Surlan of St. Louis & Carver in night off
Later part. Putting up to it saw a Bark
Lat Long

108 Tuesday August 1st

First & Middle parts
of these 24. Light air. Latter part
Smart breeze. beating up to the Land
saw 2 Gulls. Saw distant 2 Miles

109 Wednesday 2nd All part part strong breeze
from the Westward. Middle part
wind hauled to E. Laying off & on at Carver
Boat a share.

110 Thursday 3rd from men with fine weather
Boat was a share at Carver. ~~Lat~~
sunset. Boat came on board. Middle part standing
to S. W. Later part employed repairing
Fore top sail.

111 Friday 4th All these 24 hours fine
weather and smart breeze from the
South and West saw 2 Gulls (Merchant men)
Ship heading to Westward

112 Saturday 5th Lat 37 21 S Long 32 36 W
All these 24 hours Light
air. From the Westward on opposite sides
saw 2 Merchant men Lat 38 54 S Long

Cath. Catherwood bound Westward
Monday August 6th 1848

113 All these 24 hours
fine weather & Light air. Breeze to get
to Westward in ends. Lat Long

114 Monday 7th All these 24 hours and light
air and fine weather
Lat Long

115 Tuesday 8th All these 24 hours as usual Light
air and smart wind heading to South & West

116 Wednesday 9th All these 24 hours Light
air from the quarter that we
want to go. Saw two or three Gulls
Lat Long

117 Thursday 10th All these 24 hours from
with Light air from the Westward
and fine weather on opposite sides
Lat Long

118 Friday 11th All these 24 hours Light
air from the Westward heading to S. W.
Later part saw 2 Brigs.
Lat Long

119 Saturday 12th All these 24 hours
Light air and calm the
two Brigs in sight. (but no Whales)
Lat 39 06 S Long 37 14 W
