

Bark Catherwood bound to the
Western Islands
Monday July 18th 1845

96 All Shore 24 hours Light air from
South & East & calm. Latter part saw
a Merchant Brig. Liguiss saw Blackfish
Lowered all the Boats. Peterboard Boat
Succeeded in striking one. so Ends with calm
& Men off duty. Lat 37-33 Long 37-08

97 Wednesday 19th All Shore 24 hours commences
with calm calm calm calm mile to part
calm & Latter part calm & all calm
& Men off Lat 37-11 Long

98 Thursday 20th All Shore 24 commences with calm
weather. To mile to and Latter part fine breeze
from W by S. Latter part saw 2 Brigs.
Steering E by S. Lat 37-07 Long 37-37 W

99 2 Point Westerly Variation & off
Friday 21st commences with short breeze
from W by S. Steering East. Mile to & Latter
part the same Lat 37-44 Long 34-20

100 (Blue clouds E by S)
Saturday 22nd All Shore 24 of them commences
with short breeze from the Western Mile to
part strong breeze from N by W. Steering East
Latter part Light air from North Steering E by S
& Point Variation Westerly.
& Men off duty Lat 37-19 Long 33-07

101 Sunday 23rd All Shore 24 hours commences
with Light air from N by E. Steering
E by S. Mile to part calm. Latter part short
breeze from the Southward. Latter part heading E by S
made the Island of Flores shearing N by E. off
our Lead Boat.

Bark Catherwood off the Western Islands
Monday July 24th 1845

102 All Shore 24 hours commences
with short breeze from the South & East
at 4 P.M. Glaces shearing East for compass
true 30 Miles. Ship heading to S & E.
Mile to part steering S by E. Latter part
2 m. saw Hayak. E by S for compass. saw
2 or three Quils.

103 Tuesday 25th Ship heading in for the passage
saw two or three sails. Latter part Laying off on
Boat a Shore.

104 Wednesday 26th All Shore 24 hours
Laying off & on saw Ship Mercury
of New Bedford & Mot 145 Tons. Chandler Paris.
Taken 22 days before. (4th Barter 27 days before)

105 Thursday 27th Land 10 Miles distant
Employed Breaking out salt

106 Friday 28th Finished breaking
out & heading in for the
harbour to Land it.

107 Saturday 29th All first part
of Shore 24 hours Land 12.6 mls of all
Mile to part steering out across the Land
Latter part steering S by W. in company
with Bark George Washington.

108 Sunday 30th All first part commencing
with the Washington. Latter part the
Bark & a Brig. in sight
Lat 37-33
