Strong breezes and squally. Saw 3 sails standing to S.E.
Cook & one man off Lat Long

78 Friday 30th
All these 24 hours
Squally, Rainy. Lonesome, homesick. Disagreeable
weather Employed thinking of the past & future
Saw a Merchant Brig. 20 Ems this month
Cook & one man off Lat Long

79 Saturday 1st July 1848.

This day commences
with squally weather. Oh, Dear, where was I
one year ago to day. I was at home with
the pretty girls. Oh, poor Guy Seal
Oh poor Guy Seal if I had you by my
side how happy should I feel.
Sailed to 4 latter parts. Strong breezes from the West.
Cook & one man off Lat Long

80 Sunday 2nd
These 24 hours commences
with smart breezes from the Westward and squally
Sailed to part the same. Latter strong breezes and
fair weather off. Lat Long

81 Monday 3rd
All these 24 hours fresh
breezes and squally sea. All latter part
flowed down our side
Lat Long

82 Tuesday July 4th 1848
The fourth of July
on board the Bark Catherwood. Fine weather.
Strong breezes. Had a big Plum pudding
for dinner, and no more work in
the evening. Ship on opposite tack

Cook & one man off Lat Long 42-46W

83 Wednesday 5th
All these
24 hours fine weather. Saw nothing
off Lat Long 34-48 Long 42-48

84 Thursday 6th
These 24 hours com-
mences with fine weather and smart breezes. At
first part saw a School of sperm
Whales. Lowered but with out success.
going quick to windward. Sailed to and
latter part squally. Saw nothing
off Lat Long 33-51 43-23

85 Friday 7th
These 24 hours
commences with fine weather & smart
breezes from the Westward, on opposite
tack. Sailed to part the same latter
part stormy S.E.
off Lat Long 34-26 Long 43-48

86 Saturday 8th
Commences with fine breeze
from the Westward at first part stormy S.E.
Sailed to part heading to North & West latter
part heading to S.E.
off Lat Long 35-03 Long 43-23
