Sunday June 18th 1848.

66 All these 24 hours commences with smart
breezes from the Northward. Middle & latter parts
strong breezes, heading to N + W.
Lat 34 1/2 Long

67 Monday 19th All these 24 hours strong
breezes from N + W. First and middle parts
heading to North. Latter part the same.
Lat Long

68 Tuesday 20th All first part Light air
from the Northward & N.W. Middle part
Light air and calm with Rain squalls. Latter
part Light air from the Eastward heading to
North. Lat 36 1/2 Long 44 1/2 W

69 Wednesday 21st All these 24 hours commences
with light breeze and fine weather Middle part
calm. Latter part fine breezes from N + E
Ends with fine weather. Lat Long

70 Thursday 22nd All these 24 hours fine
breezes from N + E. Latter part spoke the
Bark Superior off and for New London 31 days
haul her to the Horn and buried one man and had
4 men on Board sick with the Small Pox.
Lat Long 41 1/2 W

71 Friday 23rd All these 24 hours
Smart breezes from the Northward & East
First and middle parts steering E by S
& N. Latter part steering N.W.
Lat Long

Saturday June 24th 1848.

72 All these 24 hours fine
with smart breeze from N.E.
Middle part Light air and calm
& latter part smart breeze from Northward
and Westward steering N.W.
Lat 35-33 Long

73 Sunday 25th Commences with
smart breezes from N + W, and fine
weather. All first part saw a fair standing to
Northward & Eastward. Lat Long
book off duty

74 Monday 26th All these 24 hours fine
weather At 2 P.M. rained a gale of
Sperm Whales. Lowered all three Boats
& succeeded in taking one to the Starboard
Boat got him along side at sun down
and set the watches. Latter part finished
cutting ~~the~~ book off duty
Lat 34 1/2 Long 40-10 W

75 Tuesday 27th Commences with fine weather
& employed Boiling
book off duty Lat 33 1/2 Long

76 Wednesday 28th Commences with fine weather
& light air All middle part finished
Boiling Latter part smart breezes 2nd
in sails Lat 33 1/2 Long
book off duty
