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farm is named Saint Pauls dome. The road lay along the opposite declivity overlooking the vale with its snug, pleasant and cottages green lawn like fields and the bright St. Pauls River outspread in fair arrow below me. I frequently had hard times to get along sometimes I had to find rivers and cross through marshes and one plain being very hard travelling all things. One most horrid black mass spread out before me over a length and breadth of some few acres. To go round it was utterly useless. To ~~cross~~ cross it I had to. So I plied up to my knees in what looked to be like Bird Leine it being very white. as I walked along over Saint Pauls Plain which to my right hand of me I discovered a high mountain covered with snow. I asked a man whom I met on the road what was the name and he told me it was the Ben Lomond Mountain 4,200 feet above the level of the sea. Passing on through the snake Banks into further having come only 14 miles stopped all night and had a good rest. October 27th I rose early and had some breakfast and started on the road being only 6 miles from Lanarkston. I could get there in a very short time. From the top of the hill which I stood, I could

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see the whole of the city as I was going along. the road a Gentleman stopped his train and asked me if I did not want a ride into the city and I told him yes sir that I would. I arrived in Lanarkston on Thursday, October 27th at 12 past 10 o'clock. I going in the city with the Gentleman. He told me that he was one of the Clergy men. He asked me if I had left a ship and I told him that I had been discharged from a whaling Barge. He pulled a shilling out of his pocket and gave it to me. I thanked him very much. He told me to try and get work aboard of some of the ships that lay there. The first thing that I done when I got there was to get a good plume. I looked around considerable to see if I could not find any thing to do. I could not find any thing to do in the city so I started to go down to Georgetown. I traveled about 16 miles without any success. I stopped at a farm house to ask for some thing to eat and they gave me all that I wanted to eat and drink. I asked them if they did not want any one to work on the farm and they told me that they did not want any one they asked me to
