 and layed for the night, calm in the  
 evening.

Saturday, July 10. 1875

Calm. This morning. 8 o'clock. Breezed up.  
 Hove up anchor. got under weigh. Wind  
 S. fair. Wind passed Bear's Tail, 10.30.  
 Newport. 11.30. arrived at Bristol, P.I.  
 at 12.40. Calm in the evening.

Sunday, July 11. 1875  
 fine clear weather. Wind. W and N.W.  
 Layd in Bristol all day.

Monday, July 12. 1875  
 (calm in the forenoon) got all our stores  
 off. got under weigh. at 1.30 for Newport  
 W. S.W. arriving at Newport at 5.30 o'clock.  
 Layd in Newport over night.

Tuesday, July 13. 1875  
 fine clear weather the first part of the day  
 Mr. Aldrich and Party came down in  
 the steamer from Providence in the 12.45  
 Boat got under way at 2.10 Passed  
 Beeline Reef 10. 3. Passed Sow and  
 Pig Light Ship at 4.30 Passed Scapan's  
 Cove at 5.30. Calm with light breeze.  
 Wind W & S. during the day. S.W. and to W.S.  
 and back to the Southward. Arriving in  
 Cape Bluffs at 8 o'clock in the evening.

Wednesday, July 14. 1875  
 got under way from Cape Bluffs  
 at 1/2 past 4 o'clock. Wind S.W. Wind  
 died away. but a Calm. Mr. Aldrich  
 and Mr. self took the dingy and  
 started to Pull in shore. Distance  
 then from Mautucket about 5 miles.  
 off yacht let go anchor in 14 feet of  
 water 1/8 of miles from Bell Boy.  
 I stayed ashore all day. till the  
 yacht came into the Harbor and  
 let go anchor. Light breeze in the  
 afternoon from the S.W.
