Friday commenced with fine weather winds from the North wind logging off and on at Fayal 3 o'clock A. M. the potatoes came off 8 o'clock the Capt came on board capt of W. & N. West middle part light winds with rain later part fine breeze from the N. & E. steering South by E. under all sail

Sunday commenced with light winds from North steering S. by E. under all sail the middle part of this day light wind from W. & N. W. steering South by East later part of this day this day variable varying winds with squalls

Monday October 2nd

Monday commenced with strong winds from W. & N. W. heavy rain squalls steering by the winds to the South were middle part of this day strong winds from the W. & N. steering by the winds to the S. E. later part of the day heavy squalls with rain & lightning by the winds to the N. E. under double reefed sails

Tuesday October 3rd

Tuesday commenced with strong winds from South 12 o'clock tact ship's Wood to W. & N. under double reefed top sails 4 o'clock A. M. took in Main sail & jib 7 A. M. took in Fore Top sail close reefed Main & Mizen Dark cloudy with heavy squalls the middle part of this day strong winds from S. E. steering by the winds to the South ward under double reefed top sails later part of this day strong winds from S. E.

Wednesday October 4th

Wednesday commenced with strong wind from S. E. steering by the winds to the N. W. middle part strong winds from S. E. steering S. by E. with rain squalls - later part of the day fine weather with a few rain squalls.
