Tuesday October 24th

Tuesday Commenced with Light winds from the East & S.E. steering to Southward all of this Day variable winds from S.E. to South steering by the winds to the South under all sail 5 Ships in sight the Sick no biter

Wednesday 25th

Wednesday Commenced with Light winds from S.E. steering by the winds to the S. West under all, Middle and later part of this Day Strong winds from South to S.E. steering by winds on the Starboard & Larboard tacks all this fine weather - Sick no biter
