Wednesday commences with light winds from N by E steering by the winds to the North - 1 o'clock under Double Reefed top sail 2 o'clock made all sail 6 A.M. took ship stood to S.W. middle part of this day winds N.W. steering West under all 3 o'clock Double Reefed the top sails winds W.N.W. later part winds from West by the winds to the South West under Double Reefed top sails

Thursday 14<sup>th</sup>

Thursday commences with strong winds from N by E steering by the winds to the South - 1 o'clock under Double Reefed top sail 2 o'clock took ship stood to the North - 1 o'clock middle part winds from West steering by the winds to the N.W. later part winds from W.S.W. steering by the winds to N.W. under Double Reefed top sail - today saw 3 ships steering to East West
