Lat 7-44.0 Friday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W. by W. under all sail. Middle and later part of this day light winds from S.E. by South steering N.W. by N. under all sail to day set up the fore rigging & saw larval - Suffer Bottoms

Lat 6-50.1 Saturday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by East steering N.W. under all, middle and later part strong winds fine weather &c.

Sunday 28th

Lat 5-32.1 Sunday Commenced with light winds from S.E. steering N.W. under all sail &c. Middle part strong winds, later part light from S.E. steering N.W. under all sail to day fine beautiful weather very warm &c. saw a Bone Shark

Monday 29th

Lat 4-40.1 Monday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W. under all sail &c. Middle and later part of this day light winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W. under all sail to day set up the fore rigging

Tuesday 30th

Lat 3-53.1 Tuesday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W. under all sail &c. Middle and later part fine weather light breeze from S.E. by E. steering N.W. under all sail to day turning in the main Rigging

Wednesday 31st

Lat 3-18.1 Wednesday Commenced with strong winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W., middle and later part of this day light winds, dark and cloudy with a few rain squalls &c.

Lat 2-33.9 Thursday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W. under all sail; middle and later part of this day light winds from S.E. by E. steering N.W. under all sail to day commencing down the Rigging &c.

Friday 2^d

Lat 2-12.1 Friday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by East steering N.W. under all sail. Middle and later part of this day light winds from S.E. by South, to day rattling down &c.

Saturday 3^d

Lat 2-00.4 Saturday Commenced with light winds from S.E. by S. steering N.W. North under all sail. Middle and later part of this day light winds from S.E. by S. under all sail to day repairing & rattling down &c.

Sunday 4th

Lat 2-30.9 Sunday Commenced with light winds from S.E. steering West 5 o'clock took Ship Cole 1000 Bbls oil. Middle and later part light winds from E.S.E. steering N.W. South under all sail fine beautiful weather

Monday 5th

Lat 2-37.9 Monday Commenced with light winds from E.S.E. steering N.W. Middle and later part of this day light winds from E.S.E. steering N.W. under all sail to day dark cloudy weather falling down &c.

Tuesday 6th

Lat 1-56.9 Tuesday Commenced with light winds from E.S.E. under all sail, middle and later part of this day light winds from S.E. steering N.W. by N. under all sail. All this day rattling & taring down &c.
