Friday 18th May

Latitude & Longitude Friday commenced with strong winds from W.W. steering by the wind to N.W. under all sail 4 o'clock took in the flying jib & mid top galeut sail 6 o'clock tack up the S.W. wind to N.W. West, 10 o'clock P.M. tack ship to the N.W. winds West. Later part of the day fine clear with wind from S.W. steering N.W. under all sail

8. Mon. & 8. day 8. Cut  Saturday 19th

Latitude & Longitude Saturday commenced with a light breeze from S. West steering N.W. 30 min past 12 o'clock. Landed the boat for Right Whales the Larb. Boat went on & struck on brought him to the ship & cut him in finished cutting 9.30 A.M. cleared up at the watch. Middle part of this day steering by the wind to the West under all top sails later part of the day steering E by North 10 o'clock P.M. commenced boiling Tea.

Sunday 20th

Latitude & Longitude Sunday commenced with light breezes from S.E. steering by the wind to the Eastward 3 o'clock A.M. saw the Land 5 A.M. were ship to the S.W. 7 o'clock cut off W by North. The Middle and later part light winds from South 11 P.M. thick fog 12 cleared off again

Monday 21st

Latitude & Longitude Monday commenced with moderate breezes from South steering N.W. 1 o'clock A.M. took the ship Staysman nothing this day. The Middle part light rain later part of the Day light wind from the S.E. steering N.W. by North thick fog

Tuesday 22nd

Latitude & Longitude Tuesday commenced with a very light breeze from the S.E. steering N.W. by W. under hole top sails & main top galeut sail 5 o'clock P.M. calm 9 o'clock very light wind from the North West steering E.N.E. under hole top sails & main top galeut sail later part a snow storm

Wednesday 23rd

Latitude & Longitude Wednesday commenced with light breeze from N.W. steering by the wind to N.E. under hole top sails & main top galeut sail flying jib & 8 o'clock A.M. finished boiling wind from the N.W. with light snow squalls 8 o'clock P.M. commenced steering in the main hatch later part of this (Day) fine beautiful weather

Thursday 24th

Latitude & Longitude Thursday commenced with a calm 4 A.M. very light breeze from the W.S.W. steering by the wind to N.W. under all sail Middle part of this day light wind from the W.S.W. by the wind to the N.W. 4 P.M. saw the Land bearing N.W. 15 mls. dist 7 o'clock Landed the Boat went on shore saw several Polar Whales very wild

Friday 25th

Latitude & Longitude Friday commenced with strong winds from W.S.W. lying off and on the Land 2 A.M. the Boat came on shore got under went on shore again saw a few whales the Boat went on struck was obliged to leave the whale close to the rocks & got on board thick fog & calm later part of this day thick fog & calm
