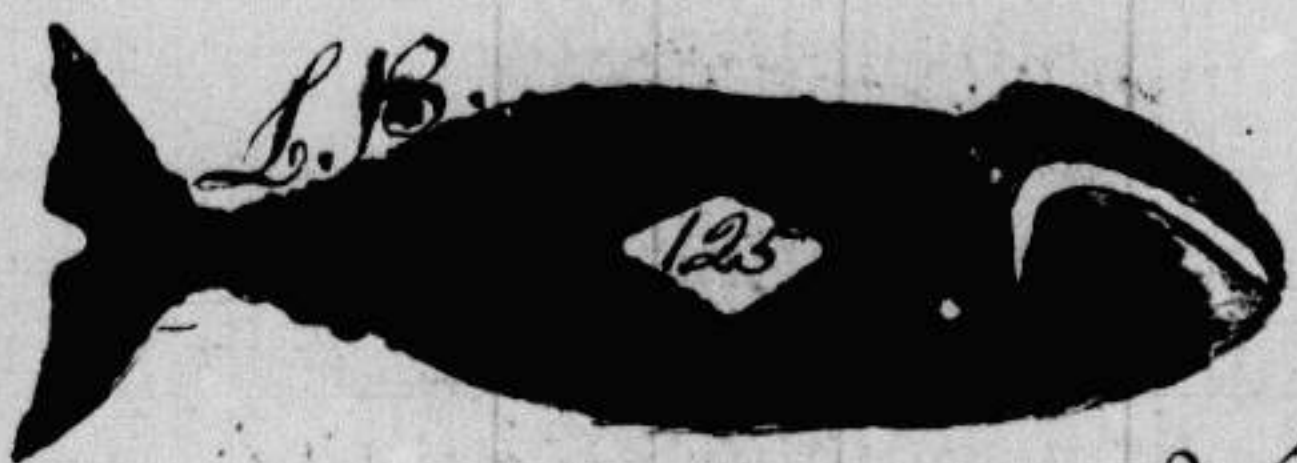


Log Book Ship Chandler Rice



Saturday 26th

Saturday commenced with very light breezes from the West-ward steering to the N.E. 12 O'clock saw the Land bearing N. by E. 1 O'clock A.M. cleared off sent two Boats on Shore we found the whale about 200 feet from where we left him hooked on to him & towed him the ship & cut him. Later part of the day strong Breezes from W. & W. under double reefed top sails 10 O'clock P.M. commenced hooking strong Breezes

Sunday 27th

Lat 58-40 Sunday commenced strong breezes from W. & W. by the wind to the South & N.W. Long 152-47 The middle and later part of this day strong Breezes with thick fog under double reefed top sails



Monday 28th

Monday commenced with moderate breezes from the W. & W. by the winds to the South-ward Boiling middle part of this day strong breezes by the winds to the W. under double reefed top sails. 6 P.M. made all sail very light winds from S.E. steering

Lat 58-45 to the N.E. light fog 10 P.M. saw a dead whale Long 152-59 took him a long side cut him in 2

Tuesday 29th

Lat 58-38 Tuesday commenced with light breezes from S. & S. by the winds upon the Land & back cutting & boiling & 7 A.M. finished cutting the middle & later part of this light winds from the S.E. & under double reefed top sails thick fog with snow

Wednesday 30th

Lat 58-10

Long 151-45

Wednesday commenced with a very light breeze from S.E. by E. steering by the winds to the South-ward Boiling under double reefed top sails. The middle & later part of this day light wind from the East with a thick fog

Thursday 31st

Thursday commenced with a very light breeze from Lat 58-50 the S.E. by the wind to the E. & N.E. 7 A.M. winds N.E. Long 153-06 12 O'clock winds N.W. by the winds to the North 3 P.M. saw the Land bearing N. N.W. dist about 10 mls 7 P.M. sent 2 Boats on Shore saw no whales Later part of this day thick fog slowing down &c

Friday June 1st

Lat 58-32 Friday commenced with a strong breeze Long 152-50 from W. & W. by the winds to the South-ward under hole top sails & Boiling & slowing down middle part of this day light fog steering East under hole top sails Later part of the day thick fog & calm today all hands slowing down in the Harbor side of the main hatches

Saturday 2nd

Saturday commenced with very light breezes from the S.E. & thick fog by the winds to the South middle part calm later part very light winds from the South land in sight bearing North 25 mls distant 8 P.M. saw a polar whale about the Boats in Chase no success
