Thursday July 5th

Thursday commenced with moderate breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind about 7 hours tack the middle and later part strong breeze with rain & fog. Spoke Ship China 4 whales this season

Friday 6th

Friday commenced with strong breeze from N.E. by the wind to the East. Under double reefed top sails & jib. the middle & later part of this day light wind from W.N.W. by the wind to the S.W. 6 o'clock P.M. made the land Bird Island bearing S.S.W. Round the West 40 mls

Saturday 7th

Saturday commenced with light wind from N.W. by the wind to North under all sail. the middle and later part strong breeze from the N.W. by the wind to the North & South. Later part under double reefed top sails and

Sunday 8th

Sunday commenced with a light breeze from the West - sailing with the main yard aback heading to the South - wind fine clear weather no whales. Spoke Thomas Dickason 4 whales Raindere 8. Round Island bearing N.W. 15 mls dist

Monday 9th

Monday commenced with light breeze from the North - wind by the wind to the East - wind under short sail. the middle and later part light wind with thick fog. Spoke Bark Corrigton clear Round Island bearing West 24 mls dist

Tuesday 10th

Tuesday commenced with a light breeze from N.E. by the wind to east - under double reefed top sails the middle and later part of this day light wind from S.W. with thick fog. Spoke the Bark Gentleman clear 10 ships in sight on Boiling Round Island bearing S.W. by W. 28 mls dist

Wednesday 11th

Wednesday commenced with light winds from N.W. by the wind to the South - under all sail. the middle and later part of this day light variable winds from the West Round Island bearing N.W. 20 mls dist 15 ships in sight on Boiling

Thursday 12th

Thursday commenced with a light breeze from the N.W. by the wind to the North & West under all sail. the middle and later part of this day light bearing winds from the north - wind. steering to the West - wind through the ice Round the North by East small shanty N.W. 38 mls dist. Spoke Bark Murcher 4 whales this season

Friday 13th

Friday commenced with very light breeze from North - wind steering to West - wind through thin ice with 4 other ships. 5 o'clock A.M. saw a whale game chase the L. Boat went on & struck parted the short warp in the bowline the L. B. struck him a game we caught him to the ship & cut him in 2 c. the later part thick fog 11 P.M. commenced Boiling
