

Wednesday 22nd

Wednesday commenced with a calm the middle part strong winds from the N. West. Later part calm finished Boiling to day saw plenty whales.

Thursday 23rd

Thursday commenced with light breeze from the West to day saw plenty whales but very wild

Friday 24th

Friday commenced with strong winds from N. East lying too anchor the middle & later part of this Day fine clear weather very few whales

Saturday 25th

Saturday commenced with a calm, the middle & later part light winds from all point of the compass to day took the anchor and drifted it again Eagle point bearing N. S. W. Stink Island East

Sunday 26th

Sunday commenced with very light winds from the N. E. the middle & later part calm saw very few whales to day

Monday 27th

Monday commenced with light winds from N. N. W. lying too anchor the middle & later part of this Day fine clear weather saw few whales but wild as usual

Tuesday 28th

Tuesday commenced with a strong breeze from N. W. lying too anchor the middle & later part of this day Moderate Gale from N. West clear weather no whales 6 o'clock P. M. took the anchor made sail by the winds to N. N. E. under full top sails & sail.

Wednesday 29th

Wednesday commenced with light winds from the North - and steering for Feklistoff Harbor for wood & water 3 P. M. dropped the anchor the middle & later part of this day getting off wood & water

Thursday 30th

Thursday commenced with light winds from N. E. fine clear weather 2 o'clock P. M. hove up the anchor steering by the winds for the N. West part of Feklistoff. middle part calm later part strong winds from the N. N. East

Friday 31

Friday commenced with light winds from the N. N. W. 2 P. M. dropped the anchor again the N. W. part of Feklistoff bearing S. E. the middle part calm. later part strong winds from N. N. W. to day saw a few whales no success

Saturday September 1.

Saturday commenced with light breeze from N. W. 4 A. M. took the anchor. stood to the N. N. W. about 6 m. l. & drifted it again. the middle part calm later part blowing a moderate gale from the N. N. W.

Sunday 2nd

Sunday commenced with strong winds from N. W. 1 A. M. took the anchor & steered off for Feklistoff 7 o'clock dropped the anchor in Feklistoff Bay 11 P. M. took it again steering to the North & West - and all of this day fine weather
