

Monday 3rd September

Monday commences with light winds from N.N.W. Steering to the West and under all sail. 7 A.M. drift the anchor again. The middle part blowing a moderate Gale from N.W. with rain squalls. Later part quite moderate. 12 O'clock took anchor again by the winds. To day saw no Whales

Tuesday 4th

Tuesday commences with a light breeze from N.N.W. by the winds, to the South and North and 6 O'clock P.M. anchored in Teklitoff Bay. From N.W. the middle & later part of this day strong winds

Wednesday 5th

Wednesday commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. laying to anchor. The middle & later part of this day fine. 10 O'clock light winds from the North and to day repairing the main top sail

Thursday 6th

Thursday commences with light breezes from the N.W. laying to anchor. The middle part of this day strong squalls from the East and. 6 O'clock P.M. took the anchor made sail stowed to the West and fine beautiful weather. Saw a few Whales. Sowed no success

Friday 7th

Friday commences with light winds from the N.N.W. Steering off to the N.E. through the passage between Big Shants & Teklitoff. The middle & later part of this day light breezes from the N.N.W. under all sail. Spoke Ship deers & the Bark, N. p'tis

Saturday 8 September

Saturday commences with very light winds from the N.N.W. Steering N.E. under all sail. The middle part of this day had light breezes from the North. Steering by the winds to East and under all sail. The later part thick fog

Sunday 9th

Sunday commences with a light breeze from the North by the winds to East and. The middle part calm. Later part moderate breezes from E.N.E. Steering by the winds to the North and under all sail. The middle & later part of this day thick fog

Monday 10th

Lat 56-13.1. Monday commences with strong breezes from the N.E. by East Long 44.44. Steering by the winds to the North and 3 O'clock A.M. tack ship to the East and. The middle & later part of this day strong breezes from the N.E. 6 O'clock double reefed the top sails took in the jib thick happy weather

Tuesday 11th

Lat 55.57. Tuesday commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. Steering by the winds to the North and under double reefed top sails 4 O'clock tack to the East and. Shook out the deers & set the main & top galent sail. The middle & later part moderate breezes from North. Steering East

Wednesday 12th

Lat 56.01. Wednesday commences with strong winds from N.N.W. Steering East under all sail. The middle part moderate breezes from N.N.W. 10 O'clock P.M. took in fore & main top galent sails. Later part of the day strong winds & clear weather
