Latitude 53-30. Longitude 51-43 Saturday 22nd

Saturday commenced with a moderate gale from E.S.E. by the winds to the South - at 12 O'clock saw Right Whales, lowered the boats the S. Boat struck & killed a whale, the whale sunk, lost him & the middle part strong breezes. later part rather moderate

Sunday 23rd

Sunday commenced with moderate breezes from North - and by the winds to the South. 10 O'clock A.M. lowered the boats for Right Whales the S. Boat went on & struck. brought him to the ship & cut him in & finished cutting 9 O'clock P.M. middle part moderate water. later part strong breezes saw a few whales no success. 12 O'clock commenced Boiling

Latitude 53-18. Longitude 51-25 Monday 24th

Monday commenced with strong winds from N.N.W. by the winds, boiling under double reefed top sails. the middle & later part blowing a moderate Gale from N.N.W. 8 O'clock took in the fore & main top sails & jib, 12 O'clock, close reefed the main & 8 O'clock P.M. the fore sail & jib

Tuesday commenced with a moderate Gale from N.N.W. by the winds to the N.N.E. at 10 O'clock took in the fore & main top sails & jib, 12 O'clock, close reefed the main & 8 O'clock P.M. the fore sail & jib

Wednesday commenced with moderate Gales from N.West by the winds to the North & East, Boiling, under two top sails & jib 10 O'clock A.M. saw Right Whales lowered the Boats no success, 4 O'clock took in main top sail & jib 7 O'clock took in the fore sail. the middle & later part of this moderate Gales from N.West & N.N.West

Thursday 27th

Thursday commenced with moderate Gales from N.N.West, laying too upon the Starboard tack Boiling 10 O'clock took in the fore sail the middle and later part the winds was rather moderate finished Boiling later part of the Day stowing down Spoke Ship Charles Phelps 800. this season Cumulge 1000. Bbls. this season

Friday 28th

Friday commenced with light winds from N.West by the winds to N.E. East 7 O'clock took in the fore & main top sails & jib, 12 O'clock, close reefed the main & 8 O'clock P.M. the fore sail & jib
