Latitude 52.56 Lon 52.20 Sunday 30th September

Sunday commences with light breeze from the West South-West by the wind to the North under all sail 10 o'clock A.M. lowered the boats for Right whales no success. The middle and later part of the day the winds W & West fine weather, saw on whale lowered no success Spoke Ship N. M. road

Latitude 53-09 Lon 52-15 Monday 1st October

Monday commences with light breeze fine clear weather winds W. S. W. Boats down chasing whales in the middle & later part of this day fine beautiful weather winds E. S. East saw no whales, 7 ships now in being

Latitude 52.25 Lon 52.47 Tuesday 2^d

Tuesday commences with light winds from the E. S. East steering by the winds to the South and under all sail 6 o'clock took in sail for the night. The middle & later part moderate gales from the North & North East laying too thick rainy weather

Latitude 52.10 Lon 52-52 Wednesday 3rd

Wednesday commences with moderate gales from the N. W. E. steering S. S. East under all sail. Close reefed top sails & for sail. 4 o'clock took in the fore & main top sails. fore sail. Close reefed the main top sail came by the winds upon the Star tack 9 o'clock cut off E. S. E. 6 o'clock P.M. came by the winds on the Larbert Tack. Sat for 8 main top sails & jib & 6 o'clock was ship to the South 12 o'clock were back again, strong winds from W & West with hail squalls.

Thursday commences with strong winds from W. N. West by the wind to the North and under double reefed top sails & main sail & A.M. took in jib & main sail, close reefed the main top sail. 6 o'clock close reefed the fore top sail, middle part by the winds to the North 6 P.M. took her off wore round to W by South, under double reefed top sails main sail & jib &

Latitude 53-08 Longitude 52-35 Friday 5th

Friday commences with strong breeze from N. N. W. steering by the winds to West and under hole top sails & courses, 3 o'clock sat flying jib 6 o'clock took in sail for the night. 3 o'clock P.M. the wind hauled to the S. S. West by the winds to the West and under hole top sails. to day saw on whale too late to lose the Boat

Saturday 6th

Saturday commences with strong breeze from S. S. West steering North West 12 o'clock Spoke Ship Hannett 500 kts 6 o'clock took in sail for the night. later part steering off N. E. saw one whale going fast to the West and did not lose

Sunday commences with light winds from W. S. W. steering off E. N. E. under all sail 3 o'clock saw Right whales to the Boat no success 6 o'clock took in sail for the night. middle part strong winds with light for fore - S. S. West by the winds to the West and 9 o'clock wore ship to S. East. Sat for 8 main top sails 10 o'clock sat the jib. later part strong breeze & light fog. Latitude by account 54.10 Lon 51-10
