Latitude 54-06, Lon 52-35, Monday October 8th

Morning commenced with moderate gales from S. West by the winds to S.E. under double reefed top sails & fore sail 6 o'clock took in sail. 6.30 made sail hole top sails & jib. The middle part of this day light winds from S.W. by the winds to the East. are. later part strong breezes & light fogs.

Latitude 54.23 Lon 52.07 Tuesday 9th

Tuesday commenced with strong breezes from South by the winds to the E.S. East under hole top sails & jib 4 A.M. wore ship to the West 6 o'clock took in fore & main top sails & jib 10 o'clock took in the fore sail & close reefed the main top sail. The middle & later part of this blowing heavy gale from South laying too upon the water tack

Latitude 53-59, Lon 52.49 Wednesday 10th

Wednesday commenced with heavy gales from S.W. laying too upon the water tack under close reefed main top sail & fore top mast stay sail the middle & later part strong gales from S. West

Latitude 52-42 Lon 53-50 Thursday 11th

Thursday commenced with strong gales from S.W. by West 12 o'clock rather moderating at fore sail & fore & main top sails wore ship to South and the middle part of this day wind is S. West 10 o'clock P.M. the wind halled in a gale to N.W. heading South under double reefed top sails & jib.

Latitude 54-35 Longitude 153-25 Friday October 12th

Friday commenced with strong breezes from the N. West steering South by West under double reefed top sails & courses middle part made all sail. the middle part light breezes from North West. later part from the South. 8 o'clock made the land Baring S.S.E. Dist. 50 mls. A.C.

Latitude Longitude Saturday 13th

Saturday commenced with strong breezes from the South by the winds to the N.S.W. under all sail 3 o'clock tack S. by E. to the E.S. East 5 A.M. tack back again took in flying jib & the main top - galant sail. middle part Duller reefed the top sails. thick hazy weather wind S. by E. East. the middle & later part light fogs

Latitude Longitude Sunday 14th

Sunday commenced with moderate breezes from S. by East by the winds to the S.W. by West under hole top sails 6 o'clock double reefed 12 o'clock wore ship to the East and 4 P.M. wore back took in the main sail & jib 6 o'clock close reefed the fore & main top - sail 10 o'clock reefed the main top sail 11 o'clock in fore & main top sails & later part moderate gales from the S.E. East

Latitude Longitude Monday 15th

Monday commenced with moderate gales from South South East laying too under close reefed main top sail & fore top - mast stay sail heading South West the middle part moderate breezes with heavy rain at fore & main top sails & jib 4 o'clock P.M. the wind halled round to N.W. West steering South under double reef 6 o'clock let out the reef out of the fore & main top sails 7 o'clock down again. thick hazy weather with rain spoke ship Debenham & Park Delaware
