Sunday commenced with light winds from the East Steering N.S.W. under all sail 5 o'clock P.M. made the Island of Kiribai in 139.04 West Longitude Lat 9.34 South, the later part of the day Capt on Shore Trading

Monday 3rd

Monday commenced with fine breezes laying off & on. today getting of coconuts & Bananas

Tuesday 4th

Tuesday commenced with fine breezes from E.S.E. 6 o'clock A.M. the Capt came on board Breced up the Mard on Perbert tack heading to North and 13 o'clock Wood if baring East 12 mls distant the middle & later part fine breezes Steering to N.W. 12 o'clock Washington it. Baring South South West - 2 p. mls distant, Nukahiwa N.W. by N. 1/2 West. distant about 40 mls

Wednesday 5th

Wednesday commenced with light breezes from the E.S.E. Steering to the West and 7 o'clock A.M. E.S.E. Cape of Nukahiwa baring West 2 mls distant have two under full top sails & pl. the middle and later part of the day light breezes Steering Down along the Coast 12 o'clock took a Pilot
