Tuesday 25th Commenced with
Light variable winds from all points of the compass
& ~~some~~ part of the time right up & down 5 o'clock
P.M. the Pilot came on board got the ship under
way 12 o'clock all clear of the head land Discharged the
Pilot made all sail by the winds to the South and
unbent the Starboard cable & stowed it away by today
when the anchor came to the Bow we found a small
Anchor about 500 pounds weight. Watched to it cleared
the cable saved the anchor &c

Wednesday 26th

Wednesday commenced with strong breeze
from the S.E. by East starting by the winds ready
for the Island Mape. 1 o'clock Capt. went on shore traicking
the middle & later part fine weather laying off
& on

Thursday 27th

Thursday commenced with light breeze from
the East and laying off & north Mape. today
one of the hands ran away the Capt is aging on shore
to find him if possible & sends the ship upon 5 o'clock
day cruise &c

Friday 28th

Friday commenced with strong breeze
the middle and later part of this day heavy rain
squalls
