

Log Book Ship Chandler Price
Sunday March 16th 1856

Commences with fresh winds from
Lat 7-01 N. E. at 1 A.M. raised Strong Island
Long 161-05 E. bearing N distant 34 miles steering
N.W. at 5 A.M. took in the fore and
mizzen top gallant sails and flying
jib latter part moderate carrying all sail

Monday 17th

Begins with moderate winds from N.E.
steering W by S under all sail at 3 P.M.
hauling up a wind at 5 P.M. raised
Heligton Island we lay off and on all day
and traded with 2 white men from the shore

Tuesday 18th

Commences with fine weather laying
off and on at 11 A.M. braced foremast
Lat 7-01 at 3 P.M. lay to, at 6 P.M. kept off
steering W by N wind N.E. at 10 P.M.
raised the Island of Assention at
3 A.M. the boat came alongside and
at 4 A.M. the Capt went ashore

Wednesday 19th

Lat 7-44 At 3 A.M. the boat came
along side at 4 A.M. the Capt went
on shore to see the doctor the ship
laying off and on at 10 P.M. the
boat came along side but the Capt did not
return employed laying off and on

Thursday 20th

Lat 7-45 Begins with fresh trades laying off
and on at 5 A.M. the boat came off from
the shore and remained during the night
at 10 P.M. the boat went ashore

Friday 21st

Lat 6-40 Long 161-58 Commences with fresh trades laying
off and on at 5 A.M. the Capt came
on board and we braced forward heading
E.S.E. by the wind at 10 A.M. tacked ship
latter part steering W

Saturday March 22nd 1856

Lat 7-28 This day begins with strong trades
Long 154-20 steering by the wind heading N.W.
middle and latter part strong winds from
E.N.E. heading N.W. under all sail

Sunday 23rd

Lat 11-47 Begins with fresh trades accompanied with
Long 153-43 rain heading by the wind N. by W. W.
middle and latter part strong winds took
in the top gallant sails

Monday 24th

Lat 14-18 Had strong N.E. trades heading by the N.W.
Long 158-02 middle and latter part the wind N.E. heading
N. had squalls of rain

Tuesday 25th

Lat 16-47 Commences with fresh winds from E.N.E.
Long 153-39 heading E. under all sail middle and
latter part steering N. by W. employed
at repairing sails

Wednesday 26th

Lat 18-15 Begins with very light winds at 3 A.M.
Long 154-09 kept off to N.W. by W under all sail
middle and latter part moderate breezes
from E.N.E.

Thursday 27th

Lat 19-01 Fine pleasant weather steering N.W. by W
Long 153-07 winds from E.N.E. middle and latter part
winds S.E.

Friday 28th

Lat 19-23 Begins with light S.E. winds steering
Long 152-38 W by W. W. under all sail middle
and latter part light baffling winds
saw some dolphin
