Lat 19-43 Saturday March 29th 1856
Long 151-38 This day begins with light calm weather middle and latter part moderate breezes from E & E course N W by W & W

Lat 20-36 Sunday 30th
Long 150-40 Begins with light winds from E & E under all sail course N W by W middle and latter part of the day had light calm weather

Lat 21-22 Monday 31st
Long 149-36 Commences with calm weather and light squalls of rain saw some dolphins latter part moderate winds from E & E course N W by W

Lat 22-23 Tuesday April 1st 1856
Long 148-00 This day begins with moderate wind from E & E set the lower standing sail took in the Starboard boat to repair latter part fresh winds from E & E

Lat 22-44 Wednesday 2nd
Long 148-03 Commences with light S & winds employed at assorting recruits middle and latter part of the day fine weather.

Lat 23-49 Thursday 3rd
Long 145-49 Begins with light winds from E & E course N W by W middle and latter part baffling winds accompanied with rain squalls put out the Starboard boat

John Curn Master 1856

Friday April 4th 1856
Lat 25-21
Long 143-47 Commences with strong winds from N & E took in the top gullant sail and flying jib at 2 a m set the main top gullant sail middle and latter part moderated set all hail course N W by W

Lat 26-14 Saturday 5th
Long 141-02 Begins with fresh E winds under all sail steering W by E employed at bending and repairing sails middle and latter part steering N W by W under all sail had heavy rain squalls

Sunday 6th

Lat 27-24 This day begins with strong southerly gales under single reefed fore and main top sail steering W by E middle had strong gales from S W under double reefed main top sail the fore and main jibs furled latter part moderate made all sail heading

Lat 28-36 Monday 7th
Long 137-44 Begins with light winds from the westward heading N by E at 6 a m tacked ship heading W by E of middle and latter part light westerly winds steering W by W under the old and bent another fore top sail

Lat 29-01 Tuesday 8th
Long 137-03 Commences with light winds from N & E steering W by E middle and latter part the wind E employed at breaking out water

Lat 29-30 Wednesday 9th
Long 134-47 Begins with moderate wind from E steering W by E Capt Curn very sick being unable to come upon deck saw a hump back latter part strong easterly gales with rain.
