

Log Book Ship Chandler Price

Crayton P Holcomb Master 1856

Friday Aug 15th.
Begins with calm foggy weather
at 9 A.M. the capt went off and
anchored the starboard boats whale
and laid him through the night
the larboard boat anchored her whale
and went to the ship. at 5 P.M.
brought one whale to the ship and
cut him in. at 11 got the ship under
way and stood up the bay for the
other whale. latter part of the day
clear. So Ends.

Saturday Aug 16th
Commences with light S.E. winds
and pleasant at 4 A.M. anchored
close to the larboard boats whale but
could not get him on account
of the tide taking him down.
at 3 P.M. the larboard and starboard
boats left the ship to look for whales
the bow and waist boats gone to S.M.
bay. middle and latter part of the day
thick fog. ship keepers employed
boiling So Ends.

Sunday Aug 17th
This day begins with light N.E. winds
accompanied with fog. lying at
anchor in shanter bay. at 3 P.M. sent
4 boats off to look for whales. middle
and latter part of the day clear
saw 1 whale. So Ends.

Monday Aug 18th
Begins with light S.E. winds
accompanied with fog lying at anchor
in shanter bay. at 5 A.M. the boats
returned to the ship. saw no whales.
ship keepers employed scraping bone
So Ends.

Tuesday Aug 19th
This day begins with light winds and
pleasant weather lying at anchor
in shanter bay. while the boats
where off the starboard boat picked
up the drug and anchor belonging to the
larboard boat about 5 miles from the
place where the whale was anchored
at 3 P.M. lowered 5 boats for whales
the larboard boat struck and brought
one to the ship. So Ends.

Wednesday Aug 20th
Commences with light S.E. winds
lying at anchor in shanter bay. at
4 P.M. commenced cutting. middle and
latter part of the day thick fog and rain
So Ends.

Thursday Aug 21st
Begins with clear pleasant weather
lying at anchor 4 boats off the remainder
of the crew employed boiling. at 6 P.M. the
starboard bow boat struck and killed a
whale and towed him to the ship. middle
and latter part of the day thick fog and
rain crew employed boiling So Ends.

Friday Aug 22nd
This 24 hours begins with calm pleasant
weather lying at anchor in shanter
bay. at 1 A.M. commenced cutting the
starboard bow boats whale and finished
at 5. two boats off middle and
latter part of the day strong N.E.
winds and thick fog. crew employed
boiling and cleaning bone So Ends.
