

Log Book Ship Chandler Price 1856

Monday Nov 3rd

Lat 38-02 = N. This 24 hours begins with light breezes from ESE. by the wind to the southward carrying all sail. at 6 P.M. tacked
Long 155-15 = W. ship. wind SSE heading E. crew employed washing bone. So. Ends.

Tuesday Nov 4th

Lat 37-10 = N. Begins with light SSE winds by the wind to the eastward. at 9 A.M. the wind hauled to ESE tacked ship to the southward. latter part of the day strong breezes took in the fore and mizzen top gallant sails and flying jib. crew employed in various duties. So. Ends.

Wednesday Nov 5th

Lat 35-47 = N. Commences with fresh breezes from ESE by the wind to the southward. at 9 A.M. the wind hauled to SSE tacked ship to the eastward. at 1 P.M. the wind hauled to the NW. squared in the yards and made all sail. course SE. latter part of the day light rain squalls. crew employed breaking out water and provisions. the carpenter at work making pump boxes. ship leaking 12000 strokes a day. So. Ends.

Thursday Nov 6th

Lat 33-24 = N. This day begins with fresh breezes from the NW. course SE. at 2 A.M. the wind hauled to NNE. braced around the yards and shifted over the studding sails. middle part of the day strong breezes accompanied with rain. took in the royals flying jib and fore and mizzen top gallant sails. latter part of the day wind E and moderate made all sail. by the wind to the SSE. crew employed washing ship. So. Ends.

Friday Nov 7th

Lat 32-20 = N. Begins with fresh breezes from the eastward by the wind to the SSE. carrying all sail.
Long 155-09 = W. middle and latter part of the day calm. crew employed spreading bone to dry So. Ends.

Saturday Nov 8th

Lat 30-30 = N. This 24 hours begins with calm pleasant weather. at 4 A.M. the wind came out from the northward. squared in the yards and set the fore top mast studding sail. course SE by S. middle and latter part strong wind course SSE. crew employed drying bone. So. Ends.

Sunday Nov 9th

Lat 28-00 = N. Commences with strong NNE winds carrying all sail. course SSE. middle and latter part of the day moderate breezes course S by E. So. Ends.

Monday Nov 10th

Lat 25-30 = N. This day begins with light NE winds and pleasant weather. carrying all sail. course S by E. middle and latter part of the day the wind N course S by W. crew employed washing ship. So. Ends.

Tuesday Nov 11th

Begins with fresh northerly winds carrying all sail. course S by W. middle and latter part much the same steering S by W. crew employed breaking out provisions and water. So. Ends.

Lat 23-34 = N.

Long 154-49 = W.
