1857

Thursday January 1st

Lat- Begins with light S.E. winds by the
14=50=N wind heading S.W. carrying all sail.
Long middle and latter part wind E.N.E. course S.S.E.
161=23=W employed setting up rigging. So Ends

Friday Jan 2nd

Lat- Commences with light winds from
12=38=N E.N.E. carrying all sail. course S.S.E.
Long middle and latter part squally took in
161=15=W the light sails. crew employed in ships
duty. So Ends.

Saturday Jan 3rd

Lat- This 24 hours begins with strong breezes
10=32=N from E.N.E. by the wind to the S.E.
Long middle and latter part the same. crew
160=33=W employed mending sails. So Ends.

Sunday Jan 4th

Lat- This day begins with fresh breezes
8=30=N from E.S.E. steering S.E. the weather
Long fine. set and took in top gallant
159=31=W sails several times during the day
So Ends.

Monday Jan 5th

Lat- Begins with fresh breezes from E.N.E.
7=41=N by the wind to the S.E. middle and latter
Long part of the day heavy rains. wind S.S.E.
159=01=W heading E. crew employed in ships duty.
So Ends

Tuesday Jan 6th

Lat- Commences with light southerly winds
7=41=N accompanied with heavy rains. by the wind
Long to the eastward. middle and latter part of
159=01=W the day calm. and rainy. So Ends.

Wednesday Jan 7th

Lat- This 24 hours begins with calm rainy
6=43=N weather. latter part of the day light winds
Long from E.S.E. by the wind to the southward
157=33=W carrying all sail. crew employed mending
sails. So Ends.

Thursday Jan 8th

Lat- Commences with light breezes from
5=17=N the eastward. carrying all sail. course
Long S by E 1/2 E. middle and latter part of
158=11=W the day E.S.E. winds heading S. crew
employed mending and bending sails. So Ends.

Friday Jan 9th

Lat- Begins with light breezes from E.S.E.
3=45=N by the wind to the southward. middle
Long and latter part of the day much the
159=01=W same. crew employed in various duties.
So Ends.

Saturday Jan 10th

Lat- Throughout this day fresh breezes from
1=37=N the eastward by the wind to the S.S.E.
Long crew employed breaking out provisions
158=59=W and water.
So Ends.

Sunday Jan 11th

Lat- This day begins with fresh easterly winds
0=25=S by the wind heading S.S.E. latter part
Long of the day heavy squalls took in
158=56=W light sails and reefed the top sails.
So Ends

Monday Jan 12th

Lat- Begins with fresh breezes from the
2=24=S eastward by the wind heading S.E. by S.
Long at 4 a.m. made all sail. middle and
158=34=W latter part of the day pleasant
crew employed making spun yarn and
repairing the rigging. So Ends.
