Tuesday Jan 13th
Commences with fresh breezes from E N E. by the wind to the S E. carrying all sail. at 2 A.M. sent down the fore and miszen royal yards and sails. latter part of the day steering S E by S. the weather clear and pleasant. employed repairing the rigging. S O. Ends.

This 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from E N E. carrying all sail. course S S E. employed mending sails and making spun yarn. S O. Ends.

Begins with fresh breezes from the N E carrying all sail. course S. latter part of the day pleasant sent up top mast studding sail booms and set the sail. steering S S E. employed mending sails &c. S O. Ends.

This day begins with fresh N E winds and pleasant weather. carrying all sail course S S E. latter part light winds steering S by E. employed unbending new sails and bending old ones. S O. Ends.

Begins with light N E winds and pleasant weather. carrying all sail. course S S E. employed in setting up the rigging. S O. Ends.

This 24 hours begins with light variable winds accompanied with rain squalls course S S E. latter part of the day steering S S W. S O. Ends. saw 1 sail.

Commences with variable winds accompanied with rain squalls. at 6 A.M. the wind came out from the southward and commenced blowing fresh tacked ship and took in the light sails. middle and latter part of the day calm. employed setting up the rigging. S O. Ends.

Tuesday Jan 20th
Begins with calm pleasant weather latter part of the day light N E winds. course S W. employed setting up top mast rigging and breaking out water. S O. Ends.

This day begins with light N E winds and pleasant weather. carrying all sail. course S W by S. latter part much the same employed setting up and repairing the rigging. S O. Ends.

Thursday Jan 22nd
Begins with light N E winds and pleasant weather. carrying all sail course S W by S. at 10 P.M. raised the Island of Whytootake bearing W distance 25 miles. at 1/2 past 10 the wind hauled to the westward tacked ship and stood to the N N W. employed mending sails and making seizing stuff. S O. Ends.
