

Log Book Ship Chandler. Price 1857.



Thursday Feb 12<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with light easterly winds  
cruising around Sunday Island in company  
with the Rebecca Sims at 2. A. M.  
called all hands and lowered the boats  
for the same whales without success  
middle and latter part of the day light  
winds stood in shore and the Capt went  
ashore and sent off pumpkins Cabages  
and turnips. saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Friday Feb 13<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light easterly winds  
cruising around Sunday Island in company  
with the Rebecca Sims. crew employed  
in various duties. saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Saturday Feb 14<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with light S E winds and  
pleasant weather by the wind to the SSW  
at 7 P. M. lowered the boats for sperm  
whales but did not see them again. latter  
part of the day. wind E S E heading S.  
saw Sunday and Macaulays Islands & three sail  
So. Ends.

Sunday Feb 15<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with light breezes from  
E S E by the wind to the southward  
in company with the Rebecca Sims  
middle and latter part of the day fresh breezes  
saw 3 sail. So. Ends.

Monday Feb 16<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breezes from the southward  
cruising between Sunday and Macaulays Islands  
in company with the Rebecca Sims. latter  
part of the day squally saw 5 sail  
So. Ends

Tuesday Feb 17<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with fresh breezes from  
the southward accompanied with rain  
squalls. cruising off Sunday Island in  
company with the Rebecca Sims. latter  
part of the day pleasant weather. employed  
making spungarn. saw 6 sail. So. Ends.

Wednesday Feb 18<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light southerly winds  
accompanied with a heavy swell from the  
S W. cruising off Sunday Island. latter  
part of the day calm. employed making  
spungarn and overhauling blocks. saw 4 sail  
So. Ends

Thursday Feb 19<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with light W S W winds by the  
wind to the southward middle and latter  
part of the day calm. saw Sunday Island  
and two sails. employed in various duties  
So. Ends

Friday Feb 20<sup>th</sup>  
This 24 hours begins with light S E winds  
by the wind heading S by W by W. latter  
part of the day calm. employed rattling  
down the main rigging and making spungarn  
saw Macaulays Island. So. Ends.

Saturday Feb 21<sup>st</sup>  
Begins with calm pleasant weather  
latter part of the day light easterly winds  
by the wind to the southward. saw Macaulays  
Island and Curtis rocks. So. Ends.

Sunday Feb 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Throughout this day fresh breezes from the  
E S E by the wind to the southward. at  
5. A. M. spoke the bark Franklin of  
New Bedford 41 men out 1250 Sperm  
So. Ends.
