Thursday Mar 12th
 Lat 49 = 00. S. Begins with strong breezes from the southward. course E by N. carrying top
 Long 144 = 24. W. mast studding sail. middle and latter part of the day light westerly winds So. Ends.

Friday Mar 13th
 Lat 49 = 11 = S. Commences with light westerly winds. carrying all sail course E by N.
 Long 141 = 14 = W. latter part of the day light northerly winds. employed making top gallant studding sail booms So. Ends.

Saturday Mar 14th
 Lat 49 = 25 = S. This 24 hours begins with light northerly winds and pleasant weather. Steering E by N.
 Long 139 = 17 = W. at 3. A.M. set the main top gallant studding sail middle and latter part of the day calm. employed in ships duty So. Ends.

Sunday Mar 15th
 Lat 49 = 43 = S. This day begins with light breezes from the southward carrying top mast and top gallant studding sails. course E by N. middle part of the day calm latter part northerly winds employed in ships duty. So. Ends.

Monday Mar 16th
 Lat 50 = 12 = S. Begins with fresh northerly winds course E by N. at 4. A.M. commenced raining took in the mizzen top gallant sail.
 Long 131 = 53 = W. at 9. A.M. took in the fore and main top gallant sails and flying jib at 10. the wind hauled to the westward made all sail. middle and latter part strong breezes. crew employed in ships duty So. Ends.

Tuesday Mar 17th
 Lat By Acc. Begins with fresh breezes from the westward carrying lower. top mast and top gallant
 50 = 12 = S. studding sails. course E by N. latter part of the day NW winds accompanied with rain
 Long By Acc. 124 = 00 = W. carried away top mast studding sail boom fished it and sent it aloft again. crew employed in ships duty. So. Ends.

Wednesday Mar 18th
 Lat By Acc. Commences with strong NW winds accompanied with rain carrying all
 50 = 00 = S. sail. course E by N by N. at 6. A.M. the wind hauled to the westward and cleared up. latter part of the day SW winds accompanied with rain. employed washing paint work. So. Ends.

Thursday Mar 19th
 Lat by Obs. This day begins with strong SW winds accompanied with heavy rain squalls. at 6 A.M. took in the fore top mast studding sail. at 4. past 6 took in the fore and mizzen top gallant sails flying jib and double reefed the mizzen. top sail. middle part of the day strong gales accompanied with snow and hail. took in all sail excepting close reefed main top sail and fore top mast staysail. latter part of the day moderated a little set the fore top sail close reefed steering E by N. crew employed in ships duty So. Ends.
