

Log Book Ship Chandler Rice 1857.

Lat 9-14=N. Long 47-22=W. Wednesday May 13th Begins with fresh trades and pleasant weather course N.W. by N. employed painting ship inside. saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 11-22=N. Long by Chro. 49-21=W. Long by Lunat. 49-51=W. Thursday May 14th Commences with fresh trades and pleasant weather course N.W. by N. at 5 A.M. spoke the Ship Arab of Fair Haven. crew employed in ships duty saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 14-01=N. Long 51-36=30=W. Friday May 15th This day begins with fresh trades. course N.W. by N. carrying all sail. crew employed in various duties. So. Ends.

Lat 16-39=N. Long 54-43=W. Saturday May 16th This 24 hours begins with fresh trades carrying all sail. course N.W. by N. the weather clear and pleasant. Employed breaking out water and wetting hold. saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 19-27=N. Long 56-14=W. Sunday May 17th Begins with fresh trades and pleasant weather ~~course~~ N.W. by N. carrying all sail crew employed reading. saw 1 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 21-21=N. Long 58-24=W. Monday May 18th Commences with fresh trades and pleasant weather. carrying all sail. course N.W. crew employed in various duties Fourth mate growing worse. saw 1 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 23-10=N. Long 60-31=W. Tuesday May 19th Begins with fresh trades and pleasant weather carrying all sail. course N.W. employed washing ship outside. saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 25-14 Long 62-33. Wednesday May 20th Commences with fresh trades and pleasant weather carrying all sail. course N.W. by N. at 5 A.M. spoke the schooner Euphemia 15 days from New York. latter part of the day S.E. winds employed painting ship outside. So. Ends.

Lat 27-24=N. Long 64-33=W. Thursday May 21st This 24 hours begins with fresh breezes. from the S.E. course N.W. by N. carrying all sail. the weather clear and pleasant crew employed in various duties. saw 1 sail. So. Ends.

Lat 29-07=N. Long 66-01=W. Friday May 22nd This day begins with fresh breezes from S.E. course N.W. carrying all sail the weather pleasant. latter part of the day light winds employed in ships duty. saw 2 sail. So. Ends.

Lat by acc 31-12=N. Long by acc 67-40=W. Saturday May 23rd Begins with light southerly winds and pleasant weather. course N.W. latter part of the day strong S.W. winds accompanied with heavy rain squalls. employed wetting hold. So. Ends.
