The Bark Chandler Price was formerly a whaler ship but was sold
into the merchant service. J. Bourne being her owner. She
was four hundred and forty two tons burden. She took in
two hundred and twenty one standard or four hundred and
thousand feet of lumber. The bark was very stiff and would carry
a long time.
