Sunday August 12th/62

this day commenced with a fresh breeze from the
S.W. all sail set but the gaff sail. steering
the wind heading about S.W. by W. at 10 AM strong
breeze and rain. the weather cleared and the appearance
of a bright night. middle and upper part
rain. at 11 AM set in the S.W. sail at 1
PM at the gaff sail. S.W. sail and
observation there twenty four hours

Monday August 13th/62

these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh
breeze from the Eastward all sail set steering
the wind heading about S.E. by E. thick
and rain. at 11 AM the wind cleared and
at 12 PM wind light heading S.E. by E. at 1

these twenty four hours commenced with a
moderate breeze from the S.E. at 10 AM the

Wednesday August 15th/62

these twenty four hours commenced with
a light breeze from the S.W. all sail set
steering S.E. by E. employed in ship's
work at 11 AM the wind cleared and at 1 PM the wind cleared
breeze from the S.W. at 4 PM breeze strong up wind
S.E. by E. at 10 AM the wind came from the S.W. by E.
passed around the yard took in the studding
sail. latter part breeze moderate heading about
S.E. by E. of compass. Latitude 45° 12' N
Longitude 36° 37' W

from Maine N.S. to Glasgow Scotland August 14th/62

Thursday August 14th/62

this day commenced with a moderate breeze
the S.W. all sail set heading to the Eastward
with the Starboard tack aboard. at 4 PM strong
breeze. at 6 PM took in the gaff sail. at 9 PM
took the floor flue of the two anchors back
or by passing a chain shot around the starboard
cathead for the flying jib gave gave bulk eye
to shoot in at 10 PM in the topmast sail. flying
jib. middle part rain. at 11 PM called all
hands and double reefed the topsail. the wind
continued to blow until about 11 PM and at 12
PM commenced to rain. latter part more
moderate. observation to day

Friday August 15th/62

this day commenced with a strong moderate gale
from about South steering S.E. by E. Park under
double reefed topsail courses & jib at 3 PM the wind
about S.E. squared in the yards a little and turned
one reef out of the topsail. at 12 Midnight set
flying jib & chain to galantail at 4 PM set jib
to galantail. at 10 PM squared in at 11 PM
the yards nearly square. employed the latter part
in strapping blocks. at 10 PM hauled the reef
out of the fore & main topsails. Latitude 55° 35' N
Longitude 30° 20' W

Saturday August 16th/62

these twenty four hours commenced
with a fresh breeze from about W.N.W.
steering S.E. by E. at 1 PM set the topmast
and lower studding sails, at 1 PM
parted the tail to the studding sail
tack block, at 4 PM took in studding
sail to galantail and hauled up the main
sail. at 6 PM hauled the jibs and took
in main to galantail, wind about S.W.
