

Remarks on board Ship Sea Trout, Capt. E. B. Ashley, S. S.

Thursday April 9th/63

these twenty four hours commenced with moderate breeze from E. S. E. and squally. at 6 AM wind about E. S. E. employed the fore part overhauling the fore part - sail - haberdashers - middle and latter part - sail - like the fore part - in latitude North
the latter part taking out water Longitude West

Friday April 10th/63

commenced moderate. at 4 AM strong. latter part fresh. employed overhauling the blocks and stuffing them over. Latitude North
Longitude West

Saturday April 11th/63

these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh breeze from the S. E. steering N. by E. middle and latter part steering N. by E. and a fresh breeze from N. W. E. Latitude North
Longitude West

Sunday April 12th/63

these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh breeze from the N. W. E. steering N. by E. middle and latter part much like the fore part. Latitude North
Longitude West

Monday April 13th/63

these twenty four hours commenced with a strong breeze from the N. W. E. raised a fine back. at 3 squared in the yards. at 1 PM wind N. E. middle and latter part much like the fore part. Latitude North

Tuesday April 14th/63

commenced fresh wind N. E. all sail set steering N. by E. employed in the rigging. middle and latter part much like the fore part. Latitude North
Longitude West

Wednesday April 15th/63

commenced fresh from the N. E. all sail set steering N. by E. middle and latter part much like the fore part. Latitude North Longitude West

Juan Fernandez to Hecla Sandwich Islands

Thursday April 16th/63

these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh breeze from the N. W. E. all sail set steering N. by E. middle and latter part rather squally. during the middle part took in topgallant studding sails. at day light set them again. Latitude North
Longitude West

Friday April 17th/63

commenced fresh wind about N. W. E. steering N. by E. middle and latter part. more moderate. employed in ship's duty. Latitude North
Longitude West

Saturday April 18th/63

these twenty four hours commenced moderate. with the wind from the N. E. all sail set steering N. by E. middle and latter part fresh breeze. Latitude North
Longitude West

Sunday April 19th/63

these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh breeze from the N. E. all sail set steering N. by E. at 7 AM strong breeze took in topgallant studding sails at 5 PM set them again. middle and latter part much like. at end these twenty four hours Latitude North
Longitude West

Monday April 20th/63

commenced with a fresh breeze from the N. E. all sail set steering N. by E. at 3 PM made land Van Dyke. wore ship and stood of shore. at 7 PM started in, employed the latter part heaving the cable and put the anchor of the bow. (36 hours this day) at 8 PM took in the Pilot. came to anchor about 5 PM came to anchor in 4 1/2 fathoms. back and 1/2 fathoms. the Captain went ashore and when the boat came back to our ship - found as found there was not a morsel of water there for us. the Ship Mount - Walston sailed the Friday previous to our commencing here
