Civil Time Remarks on board ship Cor. Thompson
Friday July 31st/63

the ship lying at anchor of Striped Bay
the boats of cruising, but those which went
the bay but saw nothing

Saturday August 1st

commenced light thick fog, at 2 AM all boats
the boats of, the Starboard boat struck & killed a
large whale, at 1 PM left the vessel at anchor
is blowing fresh for fresh and very
rough at the time, landed on the beach at
about 10 PM. The boat S. S. D. P. boat the
main boat having left during the middle of
of the day for the ship, the ship here is an
island over across the bay and part way back
again, picked up a little small dead whale

Sunday August 2nd/63

thick fog and moderate breeze at 9 AM
boat came aboard at 11 AM the main boat came
board, the other boats for the whale.

Note This Sunday passed almost away before I knew it was
the Sabbath, and I think this is the first Sabbath
ever sat since I have been going to sea and I
did not know it until it had almost passed

Monday August 3rd

commenced moderate and thick fog, driving some
gale, so the boats the two great boats of the
ship lying at anchor, some part of the time
at 4 or 5 PM the Starboard boat came along side
having felt in with the whale the ship right
and having the Starboard boat with it.
at 7 PM brought the ship to anchor, at 10 PM
breeze and quite rough

Tuesday August 4th

commenced fresh thick fog lying at anchor
about 10 AM bore up and cruised all day for the
Starboard boat and dead whale saw nothing of
of them, and so came to anchor at 8 PM

Wednesday August 5th/63

ship at anchor, about 10 AM the Starboard & boat
went in search of the whale, found him at 11
at 1 PM bore up and started for the whale, employed
the fore part-boiling a small steamer

Thursday August 6th

about 2 AM brought the ship to an anchor and
broke the whale line to the ship from the whale
at 5 PM him along side and cut him in
employed the latter part-boiling

Friday August 7th/63

commenced with a thick fog, ship lying at anchor
employed boiling, middle part-boiling

Saturday August 8th/63

commenced with thick fog at 9 AM finished boiling
is to take the anchor and went in of Florence
harbour and anchored again

Sunday August 9th/63

commenced with thick fog, lowered all four
boats, at night the S. D. P. boat stayed along
side of the ship California

Monday August 10th/63

thick fog, two boats of whaling, employed of the on
board of the ship storing down oil

Tuesday August 11th/63

commenced sailing, bore up the anchor and stood
across the bay, took a dead whale along
side and cut him in

Wednesday August 12th

this morning bore up and got a dead
whale, employed boiling

Thursday August 13th

employed boiling, the S. D. P. boat of on a cruise

Friday August 14th/63

finished boiling, the S. D. P. boat came on board
this morning, the S. D. P. went of on a cruise
back in the boat all night, the S. boat caught
a whale and took him to the ship

The ship picked up a small dead whale to day
and cut him in

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
