Remarks on board Ship for Trip Capt. A. N. from Acon. to the Southern part of the Sea Right Whaling

September Friday 25th/63

commenced light all sail set steering East from the Westward. middle and latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. at 4 AM. closed down the chains and lashed the fore anchor and took the starboard anchor upon the bow

Saturday September 26/63

these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.W. all sail set steering East. saw several Whales back during the fore part. about 2 P.M. raised Jones Island. middle part light latter part fresh

Sunday September 27/63

commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.E. all sail set steering East. E. by N. heading about E.N.E. at 6 AM. doubled right the bow at 9.30 took in the mainsail & jib. moderate gale from the S.E. at 12 commenced to moderate at 6 AM. had all sail set steering E by N. latter part fresh breeze from the Southward

Monday September 28th/63

commenced with a strong breeze from the W. steering E by N. at 2 PM shortened sail on account of evening. middle and latter part moderate Latitude N

these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze from heading somewhere to the Eastward. middle and latter part much like the fore part

these twenty four hours commenced with a light air. at heading to the S.W. at 10 AM. took in the ship heading to the S. at 12 moderate breeze from the S.E. at 3 PM. ship under double reefed topsails at 7 took in the fore & part latter part fresh gale. ship lying to under a close reefed mainsail. observation to day

Thursday October 1st/63

commenced with a fresh gale from the E. ship lying to on the Starboard heading to the S.E. at 6 AM. more moderate at 10 AM. we were right ahead at 12 under main sail steering about S.E. latter part more moderate

Friday October 2nd/63

commenced with a fresh breeze and a rough sea. wind from the N.W. steering to the S.E. under east sail middle and latter part moderate. latter part a plenty of fish back

commenced with a light breeze from the Westward steering in to the Eastward. middle and latter part light. Latitude N

commenced with a light breeze from the W. steering E by S. at 1.30 PM. raised the land Massachusetts. at 2 steering S.W. middle part S.W. by S. latter part steering S. middle and latter part moderate breeze

commenced light steering S. no signs of any whales. middle part moderate latter part fresh from the N.W. saw a sail of the he bore for some went out of sight. during the latter part raised the land at
