Friday January 18/64

commenced light all sail on starting & the wind heading the S.E. wind from the S. at 2 M. ahead the wind steering S.E. & S. middle and latter part much like the fore part running along with the land & at

Saturday January 19/64

commenced light steering S.E. & S. at 11:30 AM light to the wind heading about 2 M. at 1:30 PM. toward the Starboard boat and went fishing of Coves joined the Starboard boat went fishing toward after a while and after giving time up went ashore and got 300000. middle and latter part much like the fore part. The Starboard boat caught about 100000 fish. Latitude

Sunday January 20/64

There went four hours commenced with a light air being slack at Coves Island Starboard & Starboard boat in shore sailing the Starboard boat caught one & the Starboard boat 300000. middle part light being of a sudden the land was latter part moderate running the land down Latitude

Monday January 21/64

commenced moderate from the S.E. & S. steering about S.E. at 2 M. ahead a small island, there being a large lagoon to the Starboard of it. I believe this island is (San) Juan and as I think the island we sighted on the 2nd was not asked one at a short distance of and on during the night at 10 PM. the wind being in North by spoke the boat cut out

one from the Ship USS Goossett & Co. Newland & Brown. Brunswick nothing this season, had even a few whales the last few days

January 21/64 Round to the S.E.

January Tuesday 22/64

commenced moderate from the S.E. & S. middle and latter much like the fore part at 1 M. ahead two boats the whole being quick to the S.E. then turned fore day with 800000

Civil Time

Wednesday January 23/64

commenced moderate about 4 M. came to anchor under E. Cape Lopez. The ship commenced work from here and then left it all here. mostly humpback.

Thursday January 24/64
went off this morning, and chased whales all day, saw a number but did not catch

Friday January 25/64

hauled all four boats and chased all day the Starboard boat back and the fore boat

Saturday January 26/64

hauled all four boats the Starboard boat struck a humpback and killed him he went in about 25 fathoms of water. got him along with about 1000000 in morning

Sunday January 27/64

this morning hauled the 4 boats, did not succeed in catching finished about 6 PM

Monday January 28/64

hauled the two Starboard boats, caught on board killing
