

Remarks on board Ship Geo. Wright Capt. Wm. B. Hervey

Wednesday May 18th 1869

commenced moderate from the N. Wind at 10 AM
wind about S.W. all sail set during day
middle part light latter part a good wind
from about S.E. of the appearance of the
the sea on account of the sea for the day
and a few fish back to day Lat 56° 35' N

Long 166° 24' W

Thursday May 19th 1869

commenced fresh during the fore part back
all the light sails at 4 PM. both reefs
fore & main top sail & furl the main sail
at 8 PM the main top sail at 4 PM light
wind backing at 6 PM. now ship several
during the remainder of the day at 6 PM raised
ice on the water. middle part evening
wind from the S.E. Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 16' W

Friday May 20th 1869

commenced fresh from the E. at 10 AM. light
sails at 10 AM. main top sail at 10 AM
flying jib at heading to the S.E. Ed
middle part heading to the S.E. middle
and latter part moderate. saw nothing
but thin foggy scattering ice. at 10 PM

Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 43' W

Saturday May 21st 1869

commenced moderate all sail set at 10 AM
of the wind heading to the S. at 4 PM
backed this heading to the S.E. Ed the
snowing. latter part heading to the S.E. Ed
Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 11' W

Sunday May 22nd 1869

commenced fresh from the S.E. heading
to the S.E. Ed at 2 PM. set the fore top sail. at
10 PM. set the main top sail. at 4 PM. the main top
sail. the jib. now ship and start to the S.E.
middle and latter part moderate. saw nothing
but thin foggy scattering ice. Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 11' W

Monday May 23rd 1869

commenced moderate from the S.E. Ed. heading
to the S.E. main top sail at 10 PM. flying jib at
middle and latter part light heading to the
Ed. at 10 PM. this day Lat 56° 50' N

Long 166° 38' W

Tuesday May 24th 1869

commenced light from the S.E. heading to the
Ed. at 10 PM. of the time S.E. middle part
calm latter part moderate. sailing ice in sight
at 10 PM. this day Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 38' W

Wednesday May 25th 1869

commenced moderate from the S.E. Ed
heading to the S.E. Ed. the wind heading to the S.E. Ed
middle and latter part moderate. sailing ice in sight
at 10 PM. this day Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 38' W

Thursday May 26th 1869

commenced fresh from the S.E. at 10 PM. light
sails at 10 PM. heading to the S.E. Ed. the
ice at 10 PM. at 10 PM. set the fore top sail
gave a thick snow storm. at 10 PM. at 10 PM.
heading to the S.E. Ed. at 10 PM. commenced
moderate. latter part moderate and a
snow storm at 10 PM. at 10 PM. flying jib
main top sail heading to the S.E. Ed

Friday May 27th 1869

commenced light from the S.E. heading to the
Ed. at 10 PM. of the time S.E. middle part
calm latter part moderate. sailing ice in sight
at 10 PM. this day Lat 56° 50' N Long 166° 38' W
