

Blowing
Shoals

gave
M. L. S. S. S. S.

Wednesday (Tuesday) August 23rd 1865

commenced strong from under reefed sails
middle part all sail set. Toward afternoon, saw
one ship to the 16 miles in sight. at 6 P.M. of the north
end of Blossom Shoal, during the night worked to the

70° 30' N. Long 161° 50' W.

Thursday August 24th 1865

commenced light and continued light all day. a number
of ships in sight two boats. at 1 P.M. gained with the
Helen Snow just ahead down sailing her fourth wheel
little far being back beating N.W. wind about N.E.
and two little by her to the west. Latitude 70° 20' N. 4'

Longitude 161° 40' W.
