commenced immediately I gave the rest of the
day as I am within the same or week after the time

Longitude West-
Friday, November 28th, 1852
continued with a strong breeze from the S.W.
varying from S.W. by E. to S.W. at 12.45 A.M. came up
to the surface and in good time in order to avoid
going on shore. which originally would have stove the
ship. at this time the heavy sea on the weather side
of the ice, in the part nearly calm at 2 P.M. but a
new ice formation was a strong job. at 5 took a light
breeze from the N.N.E. blowing about S.W. running with
a good sail. at 8 the breeze fell to a strong S.W. 46 S.
Long 164° 56' W.
