There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the S E steering by the wind to the South and East at 2 PM made Cape Horn bearing S E by E dist 35 miles at sun down Cape Horn bearing S E by E dist 23 miles took in the top galing sails at 8 PM wind light from the S W middle part fresh breezes later part light breezes at day light made all sail at 8 AM tack ship quit the Channel up and bent them &c.

There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the S E steering by the wind to the North and West at 2 PM tack ship at sun down Cape Horn bearing S E by E dist 10 miles took in the top galing sails at light breezes though the light at 4 PM tack ship standing with the light at 6 PM tack ship S E by E standing into the land made all sail at 9 PM the bunch took wind out of the bay beating out of the bay &c.
