There 24 hour comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the North Course by N by E at sun set took in sail fore and main to the southward fresh breeze through the night at daylight set the top sails Course East & C

May 23
1879
There 24 hour comes in with fresh breezes and Rainy from the S by E Course E at sun set took in sail fore and main to the southward D. be calm middle part light breeze from the S by E at 11 AM Course North sailing under closed reefed main top sail and fore sail & C
- Remarks

Friday
May 24
1879
There 24 hour comes in with a heavy Gale S.W. wind from the S by E Course N by W turned up the boat took in the fore Boat middle part squall at 9. to about the fore top sails shook too reef out of the main top sail & C

May 25
1879
There 24 hour comes in with a Gale S.W. wind from the S by E Course N by W at 9 PM set the main top sailing sail middle part fresh breeze at day light made all sails hoisted down the boat put out the fore Boat & C

1879
There 24 hour comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the South Course N by E at 11 AM [illegible] 10 PM had luck middle part light breezes and rainier latter part fresh breeze from the S by E & C

There 24 hour comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the S Course N by E at 1 PM Course North middle and later part light breezes at 3 PM in sight steering to the Eastward sent up the fore top sailing mast & C

1879
There 24 hour comes in with light breezes and pleasant weather from the S by E Course N by E sent up the main top sailing mast fore and main top sailing yards set the fore top sailing sail middle part some rainier latter part light breeze & C

May 29
1879
There 24 hour comes in with light breezes and pleasant weather from the South Course N by E at 11 AM [illegible] I heard blowing forward for him and lost the name of him at 3 PM forward again and lost the name of him at 4 PM down came on board the Course N by E middle and latter part fresh breezes & C

There 24 hour comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the S by E Course N by W middle part strong breezes latter part strong breeze from the South & C

There 24 hour comes in with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the South Course N by E at 11 PM steering by the wind to the Westward at 11 PM have the Land Island bearing N by W Dist 30 miles two sails in sight steering to the Eastward at 1 PM took ship at sun down took in sail under closed reefed main top sail and fore sail at 9 PM fore ship sailing towards the Land middle part fresh breezes and squally at day light made sails running down the Land at 12 Noon Sunday Island bearing E by N Dist 3 miles & C

Saturday
June 1
1879
There 24 hour comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the S by E the Captain Littlefield tried to land on shore seeing the smoke rising high came on board at 7 PM Course E at 11 PM under double reefed top sails at sun set the Island bearing S by E Dist 15 miles middle and latter part light breezes at day light made all sails on sails in sight & C
