Remarks On board Sunday June 17th There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and squally weather from the S E by E course N E at 1 P M spoke the ^{British} ship ¹⁷ months out with 1400 casks of Whiskey. Ate had 8 Game with him at sun down took in sails hove too to the Eastward under mainmast signal, at day light made all sails under mainmast squally with rain from the S E course N E by N E.

Remarks On board Monday June 17th There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the S E by E course N N E at 8 took in the top galing sails squally middle part light breeze latter part strong breezes double reefed the top sails &c.

Remarks On board Tuesday June 18th There 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and cloudy weather from the East steering by the Wind to the Northward at sun down took to the Toward at sun down took in sails hove too to the middle part fresh breezes at day light made sails double reefed top sails main sails and jib.

Remarks On board Wednesday June 18th There 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the E steering by the Wind to the Northward at sun down took in sails hove too under closed reefed main top sails and fore sail strong breezes thorough the light at day light made sail single reef top sails &c.

S. Lat 23° 30' W. Long 174° 44'

Remarks On board Thursday June 19th There 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the East steering by the Wind to the Northward at sun down took in sails hove too middle and latter part light breezes at day light made sail and hove back.

Remarks On board Friday June 18th There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the N E by E steering by the Wind to the Northward at sun down took in sails hove too six together out 10 Old fresh breezes through the light at day light made sail double reef top sails main sails and jib at 10 P M took in the main sail at 7 P M took ship Wind N N E.

S. Lat 22° 10' W. Long 173° 58'

Remarks On board Saturday June 18th There 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the N N E steering by the Wind to the Eastward at sun down took in sails under closed reefed main top sails some Breeze heavy Breeze through the light at day light suit the fore sail at 9 P M took in the fore sail under the main top sails course N shook the reef out of the main top sail.

S. Lat 22° 00' W. Long 174° 58'

Remarks On board Sunday June 18th There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the South East at sun set took in sails hove too to the Eastward under closed reefed main top sail and fore sail thick and latter part light breezes at day light made all sails come to the fore.

S. Lat 21° 19' W. Long 175° 25'

Remarks On board Monday June 18th There 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and cloudy weather from the S E course N at sun down took in the top galing sails middle part light breezes at day light made all sail Wind N N E at 10 P M took ship latter part squally some rain.

S. Lat 20° 25' W. Long

Remarks On board Tuesday June 11th There 24 hours comes in with light breezes and pleasant weather from the N N E course N saw fine backs at sun down took in sails under double reef main top sail and fore sail middle part light breezes at day light made all sails Wind S W the crew saw broke forth 8 fine pigs and the pigs during will.
