These 24 hours comes in with a calm at 2 PM. larger for black fish. The Harbor Boat One the bow boat one the starboard boat one at sun down took in sail light breezes from the S. E. Current. Middle part fresh breeze at day light but dark red for sails at 5 PM. spoke the ship Eri. of Fox. Port with 13,000 lbs of fish weighing in the wind to the Westward. Wind N. E. tried out the black fish under saw several Right Whales

Remains On board Tuesday Dec 10 3.69
These 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the S. E. steering by the wind to the Eastward at 4 PM. spoke the ship Eri. of Fox. Port with 13,000 lbs of fish weighing in the wind to the Westward. Wind N. E. tried out the black fish under saw several Right Whales

Remains On board Wednesday Dec 11 3.70
These 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and Rainy from the E. S. E. at 4 PM. finished boiling too open sail. Gale of Wind from the E. S. E. at 5 took in the fore sail. Were ship to the South and East middle part heavy Gale at 9 PM. saw the fore sail. Commenced boiling

Remains On board Thursday Dec 12 3.71
These 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the N. steering by the wind to the Eastward at 4 PM. spoke the ship Eri. of Fox. Port with 13,000 lbs of fish weighing in the wind to the Westward. Wind N. E. tried out the black fish under saw several Right Whales

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Remains On board Friday Dec 13 3.72
These 24 hours comes in with light breezes and pleasant weather from the N. E. steering by the wind to the North and West at 3 PM. spoke the Harbor Boat struck it hump back and high jump here at 5 down for light. Whales chased with out success at sun down took in sail here too middle part light breezes at day light made sail Wind N. E. tried out the black fish under saw several Right Whales

Remains On board Saturday Dec 14 3.73
These 24 hours comes in with light breezes and pleasant weather from the S. E. at 4 PM. finished boiling made sail spoke N. E. at 5 PM. spoke the ship Eri. of Fox. Port with 13,000 lbs of fish weighing in the wind to the Westward. Wind N. E. tried out the black fish under saw several Right Whales

Remains On board Sunday Dec 15 3.74
These 24 hours comes in with fresh breezes and pleasant weather from the N. E. steering by the wind to the North and West at 3 PM. spoke the Harbor Boat struck it hump back and high jump here at 5 down for light. Whales chased with out success at sun down took in sail here too middle part light breezes at day light made sail saw several hump backs showing down side

Remains On board Monday Dec 16 3.75
These 24 hours comes in with a Gale of Wind from the S. steering by the wind to the Eastward stored down 125 lbs of fish middle part light breezes at day light made sail steering by the wind to the Westward at 4 PM. spoke the ship Eri. of Fox. Port with 13,000 lbs of fish weighing in the wind to the Westward. Wind N. E. tried out the black fish under saw several Right Whales
