Remarks There 24 hours Calm in with S Gale of Wind from  
On board the S. C. steering by the Wind to the Eastward  
Thursday set the main sail and go at 4 P.M. split the  
Mast at 5 P.M. in the main sail at 5  
4.52 spoke the High Sophia of Brumby with  
500 bbls of fish in ship and hoisted to  
the Eastward middle part fresh Gales at 7 P.M.  
More ship out the fore and main top sails hoisted  
sailed

On board Cloudy weather from the S at 3 P.M. the ship  
Friday at noon down took an sail here too to the
