Monday There 24 hours longer in with a Gale of Wind  
 August 10 from the S.W. steering by the Wind to the  
 614 North and East to the fore the fore galing sails  
 53 double reefed the fore top sails single reefed  
 the fore and main top sails at 8 AM wind  
 S.W. 1/2 S. breeze a middle part strong Gale  
 at 8 PM double reefed the main and main top  
 sails at 9 PM took in the main sail and jib  
 at 7 PM took in the fore and main top sails -  
 closed reefed the main top sails

Tuesday There 24 hours longer in with a heavy Gale of  
 August 11 Wind from the S.W. 1/2 S. steering to the Northward  
 615 middle part moderating at 4 PM all sails flatted part  
 54 light breeze from the S.W. Course W.  
 I Tided 4:58

Wednesday There 24 hours longer in with a Gale of Wind  
 August 12 at 2 PM fresh breeze from the S Course W.  
 616 at 5 AM S.W. morning at 9 Gale of Wind  
 55 from the South East in the fore galing sails  
 fore and main top sails double reefed the main  
 top sails took in the main sail and jib more

Thursday There 24 hours longer in with a Gale of Wind  
 August 13 from the S.W. 1/2 S. steering by the Wind to the  
 617 South and East to the fore the fore galing sails  
 56 double reefed the fore top sails at 4 PM  
 cut off the main top sails and the main top galing sails  
 I Tided 4:10

Friday There 24 hours longer in with a Gale of Wind from the  
 August 14 South Course North some heavy middle part moderating  
 618 at 10 PM light breeze all sails hoisted S.W.  
 57 I Tided 4:15

Saturday There 24 hours longer in with a Gale of Wind  
 August 15 from the S.W. 1/2 S. steering by the Wind to the  
 619 North and East to the fore the fore galing sails at 4 PM double reefed the top  
 58 sails took in the main sail and jib at 8 PM  
 at 8 PM Rainy middle part moderate S.W. 1/2 S. wind  
 one reefed at 10 PM top sails and the main top galing  
 sail latter part made all sails set the fore top main  
 standing sails  
 I Tided 4:40

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Sunday There 24 hours longer in with strong breeze from the S.W.  
 August 16 Course W. all sails on Middle part fresh breeze at 9 PM  
 620 set the lower standing sails and main top galing standing  
 59 sails latter part light breeze

Monday There 24 hours longer in with fresh breeze from the  
 August 17 S.W. 1/2 S. breeze, some rain middle part light breeze  
 621 at 8 PM spoke the ship Henry of Massachusetts 4 days  
 60 out of New York sent up the main Royal mast latter part  
 light breeze from the South  
 Henry of  
 Massachusetts  
 I Tided 5:25 Long 4:00

Tuesday There 24 hours longer in with fresh breeze from the S.W.  
 August 18 Course W. sent up the fore Royal mast at 4 PM  
 622 Wind S.W. breeze at 8 PM in the lower standing  
 61 sails middle part strong breeze took in the main top  
 galing standing sails took in the fore top main standing sails  
 I Tided 5:09

Wednesday There 24 hours longer in with fresh breeze and pleasant  
 August 19 weather from the S.W. Course W. 1/2 S. steering  
 623 set the standing sails at 4 PM Wind S.W. middle part  
 62 fresh breeze  
 I Tided 5:15

Thursday There 24 hours longer in with strong breeze from the  
 August 20 S Course N.W. 1/2 S. steering the ship middle part fresh  
 624 fresh breeze latter part fresh breeze  
 65 South Tided 5:59

Friday There 24 hours longer in with light breeze from the  
 August 21 S.W. 1/2 S. breeze, N.W. 1/2 S. steering the ship middle part  
 625 S. Gales, latter part light breeze from the S steering by  
 64 the Wind the Course W. made all sails

Saturday There 24 hours longer in with fresh breeze from the S.W.  
 August 22 steering by the Wind to the Eastward middle part  
 626 strong breeze at 2 PM Wind S.W. 1/2 S. steering by the  
 65 at 10 PM light set the standing sails fitting the ship
