

Remarks on Board ship Charles April 1838.

146 Wednesday 25th April 1838. Strong breezes from S.E. saw at daybreak steering to the N.E. and a school of sperm whales on the weather beam - going to the westward. - Lat 3-10 S. Long 83 West.

147 Thursday 26th Strong breezes and cloudy S.E. saw nothing. but black fish skin backs and porpoises. Lat 3-10 S. Long 83-06-

148 Friday 27th Strong breeze and clear weather. no whales - Lat 3-08 S. Long 83-11 West.

149 Saturday 28th Strong breezes and clear weather no the sight of a sperm whale - Lat 2-30 S. Long 83-30 West.

150 Sunday 29th Strong breezes. spoke the ship Midas of New Bedford 5 months out to sea. Lat 3-08. Long 83-45 West.

151 Monday 30th Strong breezes from S.E. saw 2 ships from the beam one the Midas the other a stranger. Lat 3-10. Long 83-15-

152 Tuesday 1st Strong breeze S.E. saw the ship Midas from the beam - Lat 3-10 S. Long 83-25 West.

153 Wednesday May 2nd 1838. Strong breezes and cloudy steering to the North and West. Lat 1-50 South. Long 83-50-

154 Thursday 3rd Moderate breezes from S.E. steering to the North. Lat 0-50 N. Long 84 West.

155 Friday 4th Strong breeze and clear S.E. nothing to be seen. Lat 1-30 N. Long 84-15 West.

156 Saturday 5th Moderate with pleasant weather Lat 3 N. Long 85.

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157 Sunday May 8th Moderate with pleasant whale weather - steering for the Gallapagos Islands. Lat 1-30 N. Long 85-30 -

158 Monday 9th Fine breeze from S.E. steering to the S. E. 2 ships from the beam. spoke the ship Edward Quismell of Fall River, 22 months out to sea. Lat 0-45 N. Long 88 West.

159 Tuesday 10th Steady and pleasant breezes from the S.E. the ship in sight. Lat 45 Miles N. Long 88-30 West.

160 Wednesday 11th Light breezes. some harsh calm. Coopering the ship and pork. Lat 45 Miles N. Long 88-48 West.

161 Thursday 12th Much fast this 24 hours. Light breezes and calm. Chatham Island in sight. finished Coopering the meat. - Lat 35 Miles S. Long 88-50 West.

162 Friday 13th Calm and light breeze. Chatham and Hood Islands in sight. Lat 1-11 S. Long 88-45-

163 Saturday 14th Calm and light breeze. one boat went ashore at Hood Island a fishing caught 3. Lat 1-25. Long 89-15-

164 Sunday 15th Calm and light breeze. Charles and Lancelotti Islands in sight at 9 am. lowered the boats and towed ship clear of the land. saw a barque steering to the S.W. Lat 1-45. Long 90-15-

165 Monday 16th Light breezes. saw a ship on our weather beam steering to the N.E. Lat 1-25. Long 90-30 -

166 Tuesday 17th Light breezes the Island of Albermarle in sight. lowered the Carboard boat and Lancelotti a sperm whale.
