29th Saturday Sep 25th More moderate steering N. by E. 6.
Saw 2 fishbacks. One ship in sight. Lat 7° 25' Long 81°.

30th Sunday 26th Fine breeze and clear weather steering
to the Eastward. Saw a fishback. Lat 6° 33' Long 84° 40'

31st Monday 27th Moderate trades and pleasant steering
to the N. by E. saw plenty of black fish and fishbacks.
Lat 4° 28' S. Long 82°.

1st Tuesday 28th Moderate trades and pleasant steering
to the N. by E. saw the land on our weather bow.
More squalls. Steered for Pointe Head: of 5 p.m.
beat on a wind to the S. by E. and ship on the weather
beam. Lat 3° 3' S. Long 82° 36' West.

2nd Wednesday 19th Light trades and fine weather
more towards 2 points a black fish the Harlequin
boat back 2. the Harbour back 1. Lat 3° 25' S. Long 81°.

3rd Thursday 20th Light trades and fine weather
the land in sight. Lat 3° 40' S. Long 81° 33'.

4th Friday 21st Light trades. saw a brig steering in
for Puyall. the land in sight. Lat 3° 24' S. Long 82°.

5th Saturday 22nd Fresh trades. steering to the N. by E.
fish back in sight on the weather bow saw a ship steering
to the S. by E. Lat 3° 29' S. Long 82° 23'.

6th Sunday 23rd Moderate trades and very dry. Sun as
bright. Hoop of bar. a Boquer and Bozz. Sunday for
Puyall. land in sight. steering to the S. by E.
Lat 3° 16' S. Long 81° 40'.

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7th Monday 24th Light trades and pleasant
steering to the N. by E. saw 2 Boquer steering to the S. by E.
Puyall. land in sight. Lat 3° 22' S. Long 81° 59'.

8th Tuesday 25th Fresh trades. Sun up the Coast.
steering to the N. by E. Lat 3° 30' S. Long 82°.

9th Wednesday 26th Fresh trades. on a cloudy steering
to the N. by E. Lat 3° 40' S. saw a ship of Wharf back on
the weather beam. Lat 6° 15' S. Long 83° 28' the ship.

10th Thursday 27th Strong trades and squalls. tide in the
harbour and light trades steering to the N. by E. Lat 7° 40' S. Long 84° 06' the ship 85° 36' W.

11th Friday 28th Fresh trades and pleasant steering. to the
N. by E. Lat 8° 25' S. Long 84° 06' the ship 85° 36' W.
