337. Thursday Oct. 31st 1838. Moderate and clear. 1 A.M. tack'd to the S.W.
10 A.M. tack'd to the E.S.E. saw black fish and fin backs.
Late 12-45 S. Long by Chron 81-22. W.

338. Thursday Nov. 1st Fresh trades and cloudy. Midnight tack'd ship to the
S.W. saw black fish and fin backs 3 P.M. tack'd to the
E.N.E. Noon. Late 13-08. Long 81-30 West.

339. Friday 2^d Moderate and pleasant saw 3 fin backs 7 A.M.
tack'd to the S.W. 11 A.M. tack'd to the E.N.E.
Late 13-00 S. Long Chron 80-09 West.

340. Saturday 3^d Moderate and pleasant steering to the E.N.E.
saw black fish and one fin back. Noon
Late 12-17 S. Long Chron 78-42 West.

341. Sunday 4th Moderate and pleasant 3 A.M. tack'd to the S.W.
1 P.M. saw sperm whales. lowered the boats succeeded
in taking one. at sundown took him alongside.
Noon. Late 12-38. Long 78-20 W.

342. Monday 5th Fresh Trades. at daylight wore ship and
~~Commenced~~ Cutting. 11 A.M. finished cutting.
and made sail to the S.W. 6 P.M. tack'd to the
East. Noon Late 12-08 S. Long Chron 79-30 West.

343. Tuesday 6th Strong Trades. and clear. at daylight tack'd
to the S.W. Employ'd Boiling saw black fish
and one fin back Noon Late 12-07. Long by Lunar 81
at 8 A.M. 77-58. West Chron 78-57. 6 P.M. tack'd to the East
at 9 P.M. finished boiling.

344. Wednesday 7th Moderate and clear. at daylight tack'd to the S.W.
saw humpbacks. Noon Late 12-23 S. Long by Lunar 78-33 Chron 79-02
1 P.M. tack'd to E by N. by the Wind.

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345. Thursday Nov 8th 1838. Moderate and cloudy. at 10 A.M. made the
Hornigas Islands bearing N.E. by A dist 10 Miles. at Noon made
the Cordillera's Mountains. at sunset the Island St. Lorenzo
bore East dist 5 Miles. saw the shipping in the Harbour of Callao
also a birds eye view of the City of Lima 6 P.M. tack'd to the
Headed S.W. Noon Late 12-05 S. Long Chron 77-58 West 6 P.M.
saw plenty of humpbacks and black fish

346. Friday 9th Fresh Trades. Light airs. and clear. Midst and latter part.
Strong Trades. steering to the S.W. by the Wind saw black fish
and humpbacks. Noon. Late 12-32 S. Long by Lunar 8 A.M. 78-15 Chron 78-03 W.

347. Saturday 10th Strong trades and cloudy. 3 A.M. tack'd to the E.N.E.
saw black fish 1 P.M. tack'd to the S.W. at 11 P.M.
tack'd to the E.N.E. Noon. Late 12-00 S. Long Chron 78-20 West.

348. Sunday 11th Strong trades and clear 9 A.M. tack'd to the S.W.
saw 2 fin backs. Noon Late 12-04 S. Long by Lunar 11 Miles
78-16-30 West. Chron 78-21-75 West. at 9 P.M. tack'd to the
E.N.E.

349. Monday 12th Moderate and pleasant set this small gun of 12 lb
below decks to keep the ship on her bottom. saw fin back
and plenty of black fish. Noon Late 12-14 Long by Lunar
1 P.M. 78-11 Chron 78-07 West 2 P.M. tack'd to the S.W.
at 11 P.M. tack'd to the E.N.E.

350. Tuesday 13th Light trades and pleasant Condema the Foretop sail and
trient another. 7 A.M. saw a school of sperm whales 3 pairs
on the weather bow headed about E.S.E. going quick. did not
lower. Noon Late 12-09 S. Long 2 P.M. Chron 78-33. also plenty of
black fish and fin backs 2 P.M. tack'd to the S.W. 6 P.M.
tack'd to the E.N.E.
