

Ship Charles. Coast of Peru. Dec^r 1888.

379. Thursday, Dec^r 13th Moderate trades, at daylight saw 3 Ships. Headed to the E.N.E. at 3 P.M. tacked to the E.N.E. at 4 P.M. saw a school of Thorm Whales on the weather bow headed to leeward. Toward the boats got one. Employed Boiling. Noon Lat^d 14. 05. Long 84. 17. Took the whale alongside.

380. Friday 14th Light trades and pleasant at daylight saw one Ship headed to the E.N.E. Commenced cutting. at 3 P.M. hauled in made sail to the E.N.E. Black fish in sight, Noon Lat^d 14. 03. Long 84 P.M. 84-23.

381. Saturday 15th Light trades and pleasant saw 2 Ships headed to the S.E. W. also black fish. Employed Boiling. at sunset saw a large whale headed to the westward low the boats without success. Lat^d 13. 41. Long 84 P.M. 83-34.

382. Sunday 16th Light trades and pleasant at 4 A.M. finished Boiling the 2 Whales turned up. 108 lbs. saw plenty Black fish steering to the E.N.E. noon Lat^d 13. 32. Long 84 P.M. 83-26.

383. Monday 17th Light trades and pleasant at Midnight tacked to the S.E. W. at 2 P.M. saw a ship off the lee beam starboard spoke her. the Ephraim. 650 lbs. Noon Lat^d 14. 02 S. Long 84 P.M. 83-43 W.

384. Tuesday 18th Light trades and pleasant at daylight headed to the E.N.E. saw 2 sails. Employed Coopering noon Lat^d 13. 57. Long 84 P.M. 84-38. W.

385. Wednesday 19th Moderate trades and pleasant at daylight headed to the S.E. W. Employed blowing down the oil. Saw black fish. Lat^d 13. 31. Long 84 P.M. 84-00 W.

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386. Thursday, Dec^r 20th Light trades and pleasant at daylight headed to the E.N.E. saw one ship off the weather beam. Employed sunset finished blowing down. Lat^d 14. 00. S. Long 84. 48.

387. Friday 21st Moderate and pleasant, daylight saw ship. spoke her. the S. S. W. saw a ship on the weather beam at 4 P.M. spoke her. the S. S. W. 12 1/2 months 250. Lat^d 13. 33. Long by Lunar 84 P.M. 84-00-18. Thru 83-41. West.

388. Saturday 22nd Light trades and pleasant headed to the E.N.E. saw one ship also black fish. Noon Lat^d 14. 18. Long by Lunar 84 P.M. 84-18. Thru 84-22. W.

389. Sunday 23rd Moderate and pleasant headed to the E.N.E. saw plenty black fish and one fine brock. Noon Lat^d 13. 28 S. Long by Lunar 84 P.M. 83-40-45. Thru 83-27. W.

390. Monday 24th Strong trades and hazy. headed to the S.E. W. at daylight saw a ship on our weather beam at 9 A.M. spoke her. the Henry of Antioch (brown) Lat^d 13. 26 months 1900 had left Capt. Chase at Callao 2 weeks previous on account of sickness. Lat^d 13-39. S. Long 84 P.M. 83-53. W.

391. Tuesday 25th Moderate trades. at daylight headed to the S.E. W. The ship Henry, astern at 4 P.M. wore ship to the S.E. and spoke the Henry. Lat^d 14. 02 S. Long by Lunar 84 P.M. 83-14. Thru 84-32.

392. Wednesday 26th Strong trades. at daylight the ship Henry ahead noon saw a ship on the weather beam headed to the S.E. W. saw black fish and Finbacks. Noon Lat^d 13. 19. S. Long 84 P.M. 83-45-30.

393. Thursday 27th Strong trades. at 8 A.M. saw a ship on our lee beam. noon saw a ship on the weather beam sunset spoke her the Ephraim (Lewis) 12. 650. Noon Lat^d 13. 17 S. Long 83-40.
